80% of Gen Z choosing employers based on innovation culture

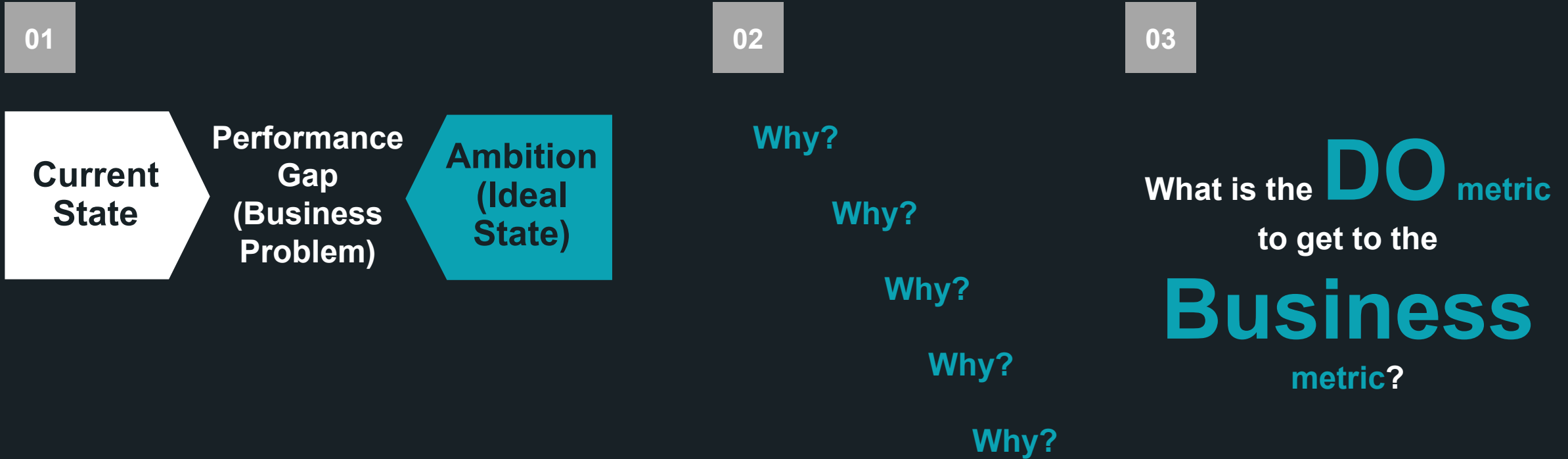
46% of execs citing tech debt as a barrier to growth
