


The Santa Monica Pier

Stop by Catch Restaurant for a cocktail and a sunset dining experience. The Santa Monica restaurant is known for their sushi, seafood, and stunning coastal views. Must-try appetizers include, the Crab Cake with piquillo pepper remoulade and the Yellow Fin Tuna Poke with a vegetable salad, radish, bamboo rice, and ponzu black peppercorn dressing. For a main dish, enjoy the Black Squid Ink Linguini served with mussels, clams, shrimp, calamari, and tomatoes. Their seared Chilean Sea Bass served with smoked white asparagus, manila clams, leeks and parsley sauce is another excellent choice.
