Call for Applications for the Quality Assurance Review Team

Med.E.A. University invites expressions of interest from qualified professionals and academics to serve as members of the **University Quality Assurance Review Team**.

The establishment of this team is part of the University's commitment to maintaining and strengthening a culture of **quality enhancement, accountability, and continuous institutional improvement**, in line with internationally recognised quality assurance principles and good practice within the **European Higher Education Area (EHEA)**.

1. Purpose of the Quality Assurance Review Team

The team will support the University in the **implementation and monitoring of its internal quality assurance framework** and contribute to periodic reviews of academic programmes, institutional processes, and quality enhancement initiatives.

It will play an important **advisory and evaluative role**, ensuring that academic provision, institutional processes, and student support services meet the highest standards of **integrity, effectiveness, and transparency**.

2. Key Responsibilities

Members of the Quality Assurance Review Team will contribute to activities including, but not limited to:

- Participation in programmes and institutional review processes
- Evaluation of academic programmes against established quality standards and regulatory requirements



- Review of curriculum design, learning outcomes, and assessment strategies
- Assessment of the effectiveness of teaching, learning, and student support mechanisms
- Contributing to the evaluation of internal quality assurance policies and procedures
- Supporting the development of recommendations aimed at quality enhancement and institutional improvement
- Participation in review meetings, evaluation visits, and reporting processes

Members may also be invited to contribute to **thematic reviews, benchmarking exercises, and strategic quality enhancement initiatives** undertaken by the University.

3. Eligibility Criteria

Eligible applicants are expected to have:

- A **doctoral degree** or equivalent professional qualification, preferably in a relevant academic or professional field
- Evident experience in **higher education teaching, research, and academic administration**
- Experience in **quality assurance, accreditation, or programme evaluation** in higher education or professional education
- A sound understanding of quality assurance principles and frameworks, including those aligned with the **Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance (ESG) of the EHEA**
- Strong analytical, evaluative, and report-writing skills
- A commitment to maintaining the highest standards of **academic integrity, impartiality, and confidentiality**

Experience with external quality assurance agencies, accreditation bodies, or institutional review processes will be considered an asset.

4. Commitment



Members of the team are expected to:

- Participate in scheduled review activities throughout the academic year
- Contribute to the preparation of review reports and recommendations
- Maintain independence, objectivity, and professional judgement in all evaluation processes

Participation may involve **document review, meetings, and on-site or virtual evaluation activities.**

5. Application Procedure

Eligible candidates are to submit:

- **Curriculum Vitae (CV)**
- **brief statement of interest** outlining relevant experience in quality assurance or academic evaluation
