

CFU-ECTS Conversion Table

Università Telematica Pegaso complies with the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), which guarantees a clear and transparent apparatus for measuring the relationship between the quality of the learning work carried out by the student and the commitment of the student. At Unipegaso, 1 CFU is equivalent to 1 ECTS credit. On average, the student has to devote about 1/3 of the total learning effort required to pass the examination through the online mode.

For the purpose of transparency in the system of attribution and conversion of grades obtained by incoming and outgoing students, the University has developed a clear conversion table exemplified as follows:

Grades	Detailed description of the grade in figures	Letter
30/30 cum laude	Represents the maximum grade achievable. It is awarded to those who demonstrate full mastery and thorough knowledge of the training content being tested.	A
28 - 29	This score range is awarded to those who demonstrate excellent knowledge of the training content being tested.	B
25 - 27	This score range is awarded to those who demonstrate good knowledge of the training content being tested.	C
21 - 24	This score range is awarded to those who demonstrate a fair knowledge of the training content being tested.	D
18 - 20	This score range is awarded to those who demonstrate sufficient knowledge of the training content being tested.	E
0 - 17	Indicates a lack of knowledge of the training content being tested. In the presence of such and successive marks in descending order, the training objectives are to be considered as not having been achieved.	F

In addition to this, the methodology implemented by the University for the recognition of CFUs earned by students attending courses abroad also focuses on the data contained in the Learning Agreement and the Transcript of Records.

The Learning Agreement describes analytically the study programme undertaken by the student during his/her stay at the host university (courses to be followed, time span covered by the stay abroad, weight of the course expressed in ECTS). The joint signature of the two institutions (receiving and sending) constitutes the guarantee for the recognition of credits accrued abroad.

The Transcript of Records, provides a clear and transparent record of the training activities carried out by the student during the Erasmus+ mobility.

Both administrative documents (Learning Agreement, Transcript of Records) are issued by the International Relations Office on the basis of the findings of the records and indications provided by the Erasmus+ coordinators of the universities involved.
