ARTICLE 1 – ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MASTER

MED.E.A. University – University for Mediterranean, Europe and Africa hereby announces the Call for Applications for admission to the Master of Science in Surgery – Implant Dentistry for the Academic Year 2026/2027.

The programme is designed for dental professionals seeking advanced education in implant dentistry through a combination of academic instruction, clinical training and international experience. The Master adopts a blended learning approach consisting of live online teaching, supervised practical sessions and research activities, enabling participants to develop advanced competencies in contemporary implant dentistry.

ARTICLE 2 – AIMS OF THE PROGRAMME

The Master has been designed to provide advanced postgraduate education in oral implantology, regenerative surgery and implant-supported prosthetic rehabilitation.

The programme aims to:

- provide comprehensive scientific and clinical knowledge in implant dentistry;
- develop competence in evidence-based diagnosis and treatment planning;
- train clinicians in advanced implant surgical procedures;
- develop skills in digital implantology and guided surgery;
- enhance competence in bone and soft tissue regeneration;
- strengthen critical thinking through research methodology and scientific writing;
- promote international collaboration and multidisciplinary clinical practice.

ARTICLE 3 – LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon successful completion of the Master, graduates will be able to:

- diagnose implant cases using contemporary clinical protocols;
- formulate comprehensive treatment plans;
- perform implant placement using conventional and digital workflows;
- execute immediate implant placement and immediate loading where clinically indicated;
- perform hard and soft tissue augmentation procedures;
- manage sinus augmentation techniques;
- restore single, partial and full-arch implant rehabilitations;
- recognise and manage implant complications;



critically evaluate scientific literature;
complete, present and defend an original research dissertation.

ARTICLE 4 – PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The Master is delivered through a blended learning model combining online education with international practical training.

The programme includes:

- monthly live online lectures;
- clinical case discussions;
- journal club activities;
- supervised clinical portfolio development;
- guided independent study;
- dissertation preparation;
- two intensive international contact sessions.

ARTICLE 7 – ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applications are open to candidates holding one of the following qualifications:

- Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS);
- Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS);
- Degree in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics;
- Equivalent foreign qualification recognised by the University.

Applicants must possess an adequate command of the English language suitable for postgraduate education.

Admission is subject to verification of academic qualifications and documentation submitted.



ARTICLE 8 – APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications shall be submitted online through the University's admission portal.

Each application must include:

completed application form;

valid passport or identity card;

curriculum vitae;

degree certificate;

academic transcript;

Diploma Supplement or equivalent documentation where applicable;

official English translations of documents not originally issued in English;

English language certificate, where available;

proof of registration with the relevant Dental Council (where applicable);

receipt of payment of the first tuition instalment.

The University reserves the right to request additional documentation where necessary.

ARTICLE 9 – SELECTION PROCEDURE

Applications will be assessed by the University's Admissions Office.

Selection is based upon:

- academic qualifications;
- curriculum vitae;
- compliance with admission requirements;
- completeness of the application.

Where considered necessary, applicants may be invited to an online interview.

ARTICLE 10 – NUMBER OF PLACES

The programme will be activated upon reaching a minimum enrolment of 15 participants.

The maximum number of students admitted is 30.

The University reserves the right not to activate the programme should the minimum number of enrolments not be achieved.

ARTICLE 11 – DURATION

The Master has a duration of 14 months, corresponding to a total workload of 1,500 hours and 60 ECTS credits.

The programme consists of:



- online teaching;
- practical clinical sessions;
- individual study;
- dissertation work;
- final assessment.

ARTICLE 12 – ATTENDANCE

- Students are required to attend at least 80% of the scheduled educational activities.
- Failure to satisfy attendance requirements may result in exclusion from the final examination.

ARTICLE 13 – TUITION FEES
