

Master Degree of Surgery in Implant Dentistry MQF/EQF Level 7

➤ Overall Programme Description

The Master Degree of Surgery in Implant Dentistry is a specialized programme designed to enhance the theoretical knowledge and practical clinical experience of general dentists in the field of implantology.

Students will be involved in modern implantology, from diagnosis to prosthetic rehabilitation, and will have the opportunity to come into contact with the latest surgical techniques and technologies. The teaching modality will be blended: a mixed mode approach to education that combines on-site lessons and distance learning.

The programme is organised through five teaching sessions in which the lesson topics will be imparted by the professors in a gradual and complementary manner.

The Master's Degree main partner is the Istituto Stomatologico Toscano in Italy, a Foundation for Clinical Research and Higher Education in Dentistry, directed by Prof. Ugo Covani.

➤ Application schedule and procedure

Applications and all required documents must be submitted through the institutional website www.unimedea.eu by filling in the online application.

The activities of the first edition of the programme will start on October 2024 and will be completed on September 2025.

Applications may be submitted within September 15th, 2024.

➤ Entry Requirements

In order for the candidates to be admitted to the Master's Degree, it is compulsory to hold at least one of the following degrees qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Dental Surgery;
- Any foreign qualification obtained abroad and equivalent in duration and content to those listed above.

➤ Language Requirements

Candidates are expected to hold at least a C1 English language level of the CEFR - Common European Framework of Reference and submit the relevant language certification.

Candidates unable to meet the aforementioned language requirements, are invited to follow separate courses to gain such skills.

➤ Required Documents

Candidates shall submit their application, attaching the following documents:

- High School Diploma as provided by the issuing Institution;
- Degree qualification certificates and transcript(s) as provided by the issuing Institution;

- Certificates/Declarations released by an ENIC-NARIC centre or other certificates explaining the foreign qualification status/level;
- Official translation in English language of the above-mentioned qualifications;
- Copy of a valid identity document (such as passport or ID card);
- International English language certificate (if any);
- Updated CV;
- Receipt of payment of first instalment of the application fee.

MED.E.A. reserves the right to verify the authenticity of the certificates provided with the competent issuing authorities.
