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Build a Fairy Tree House

You Will Need:

- Clay
- Flowers
- Leaves
- Seeds



1 Collect flowers and leaves from a garden.



2 Wet your hand and start moulding your clay. Try to make a tree trunk with two branches at the top. Make sure there is a hollow for the fairies, too!



3 Place all your flowers, leaves and maybe even some seed for birds in the branches of your clay tree.



4 Let it dry overnight and then place it into your garden for the fairies and birds to enjoy!
