- Must possess thorough knowledge and experience implementing and managing under Incident Management/Command System.
- Successful completion of NFPA 1021 Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualification Level III or approved equivalent.
- Successful completion of NFPA 1041 Standard for Fire and Emergency Services Instructor Level I or approved equivalent.
- Successful completion of NFPA 1035 Standard on Fire and Life Safety Educator Public Information Officer Level I or approved equivalent.
- Possess a thorough understanding of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act and other applicable legislation and related regulations.
