Giving back is ingrained in everything we do at FIGS, and has been from the beginning.

Going back to our founding in 2013, we felt passionate about donating scrubs to healthcare professionals who work in resource-poor countries and lack the proper uniforms to do their jobs safely. By providing clean scrubs to these individuals, we knew we could empower them and improve the quality of care they provide.

We named the initiative "Threads for Threads," and this became the philanthropic arm of our business.

Between 2013 and 2017, we based Threads for Threads on our commitment to donate one set of scrubs to medical professionals in need for every set of scrubs that we sold. We were honored to make an impact in this way.

As FIGS continued to grow as a company, so did the breadth of our mission. In order to truly serve medical professionals on a global scale, there was a fundamental opportunity to do more. We listened to our community, we watched the world change and we decided it was time to elevate our approach to Threads for Threads. It was no longer just about donating scrubs.

Starting in late 2017, we evolved Threads for Threads. What started as a one-for-one model progressed into a comprehensive aid and corporate social responsibility initiative. In addition to continuing to donate scrubs, we now make a bigger, longer-lasting impact for the community we serve – and the communities they serve – around the world.

Today, we continue giving to healthcare professionals in need, having donated hundreds of thousands of FIGS scrubs and other products to medical professionals in need.

The New Icons Grant



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Other Donations



In support of breast cancer awareness, FIGS donated \$25,000 to UCLA's Jonsson Comprehensive Cancer Center. We also launched our "Peace Out Cancer" underscrub in November 2020.

We forged a meaningful partnership with the American Osteopathic Association to support their efforts in creating greater awareness and understanding of the osteopathic profession and the critical contributions female DOs and osteopathic physicians make in our healthcare system. We donated \$100,000 to ensure AOA would have the resources to make these changes happen.

FIGS partnered with RxART to create the FIGS | RxART Artist Capsule Mask Collection, featuring limited edition FION^X Protective Masks designed by three renowned contemporary artists: Ann Craven, Dan Colen and Rob Pruitt.

RxART is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to help children heal through the extraordinary power of visual art. The organization commissions exceptional contemporary artists to transform healthcare facilities into engaging and inspiring environments full of beauty, humor, and comfort, producing every project at no cost to the hospitals.

FIGS committed to use a portion of the mask sales to donate up to \$30,000 to RxART.



Planet

At FIGS, we're committed to making the world a better place and that includes doing what we can to support our planet.

Sustainable Manufacturing



We carefully evaluate all suppliers and manufacturers to ensure they share our standards for quality of manufacturing, ethical working conditions and social and environmental sustainability practices.

In line with our values, we require all of our manufacturers to be certified through the Worldwide Responsible Accredited Production (WRAP) program, an independent organization dedicated to promoting safe, lawful, humane and ethical manufacturing. We also require all suppliers and manufacturers to contractually commit to upholding these standards.

Once a vendor is part of FIGS' production network, our in-house production team partners with third-party inspectors to closely monitor each partner's compliance with applicable laws and FIGS' standards on an ongoing basis.

To celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Earth Day, we launched our Environmentally Awesome Collection.

On April 22, 2020, FIGS introduced our Limited Edition FION^{EAC.} scrubs engineered from recycled polyester with Silvadur™ antimicrobial technology that provides odor protection, inhibits the growth of bacteria, yeast, algae, and other microorganisms that cause odor and fabric damage, and increases the lifespan and durability of the product. We offered these scrubs in three colors inspired by the planet and in both core and limited edition styles.

Growth

We grew a lot - and fast - this past year. By the end of 2020, our headcount reached 202, an increase of more than 70%.

Fostering Positive Culture

In 2020, we launched a Culture Committee to foster an empowering and supportive experience for all FIGS employees. The Committee, which meets bi-weekly, is made up of team members from every part of the company who bring their teams' ideas to the table, ensuring that all FIGS voices are represented and heard.

Supporting Our Team Through COVID-19

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we recognized the need to focus on our people and the challenges they were each facing, individually. In an effort to support their health and wellbeing, we introduced food delivery stipends in partnership with Postmates, virtual gym memberships in partnership with ClassPass, and team-building initiatives, like book clubs, seasonal recipe sharing and opportunities for community service, to nurture a sense of togetherness during a time we could not be together physically.


Incorporating Feedback
