Compliance Status

This Web site is **partially compliant** with the requirements of Appendix A of UNI CEI EN 301549 due to the instances of non-compliance listed below.

The Company is currently conducting an analysis aimed at identifying the necessary actions to make this website accessible and compliant.

Non-accessible content

The content listed below is not accessible for the following reasons non-compliance with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004:

- Requirement: 9.1.1.1 - Some non-text content presented to the user does not have an equivalent textual alternative that serves the same purpose;
- Requirement: 9.1.3.1 - In some cases, information, structure, or correlations conveyed by page presentation, cannot be determined programmatically (or are not available via text);
- Requirement: 9.1.4.1 - In some cases, color alone was used to identify a purpose or distinguish information or function;
- Requirement: 9.1.4.3 - Visual representation of text and text-containing images does not always have the required minimum contrast ratio, with exceptions provided for in the regulations (EX. logos);
- Requirement: 9.1.4.4 - Some text, with the exception of subtitles and images containing text, cannot be resized up to 200 percent without using assistive technologies and without losing content and functionality;
- Requirement: 9.1.4.10 - Content that does not require two-dimensional representation (such as data tables or maps) will not redisplay when the size displayed by the user program changes;
- Requirement: 9.2.1.1 - Some functionality cannot be used via keyboard (or similar input interface);
- Requirement: 9.2.4.1 - A mechanism is missing for skipping blocks of content that are repeated on multiple Web pages;
- - Criterion: 9.2.4.3 - On some Web pages that may be navigated sequentially, and where the sequence of navigation affects their meaning and operation, some objects that may receive focus do not receive it in an order that preserves their meaning and operation;
- Requirement: 9.2.4.7 - On some interactive elements, the focus indicator is not visible;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.1 - Page markup code does not always conform to its specification or contains errors, or duplicate attributes and IDs;
- Requirement: 9.4.1.2 - In some cases, user interface components (including: form elements, links, and script-generated components...), name, role, states, properties, and values are not correct or set, or the user and their assistive technologies are not notified when these change.

Drafting of the accessibility statement

It was assessed by a third party through objective and subjective analysis (see Article 3(1) of EU Implementing Decision 2018/1523 of the Commission).
