Works with SmartThings lock-up is used to indicate compatibility with the SmartThings ecosystem.

- Despite the Works with Samsung SmartThings endorsement badge naming, our program title remains as the Works with SmartThings (WWST) certification program.
- Due to the changing landscape around master brands, we've created a master brand (Samsung) lock-up for our endorsement logo and badge only.
- Prioritize the use of horizontal logos, use vertical only if space is limited.

1. Endorsement with icon can be full-color, black or white. The four available versions are shown on the right.
2. Always consider the overall design layout to determine the best option.

Do not create unauthorized lock-ups.

Colors: Endorsement without Icon

1. Endorsement without icon must be either black or white. Select the version that provides an appropriate level of contrast with the background color.
2. Consistent and accurate usage of color across different applications is key to building a strong visual consistency. The general color references provided to the right for printing process colors (CMYK) and on screen applications (RGB and HEX values) will help you achieve this goal.

Do not apply any other colors for the logo.



Clear Space & Minimum Size

Endorsement with icon type.



1. Always maintain a minimum clear space equal to 65% of the x-height of the logo around the endorsement lock-up.
2. Endorsement typography (Works with):
Font: Samsung Sharp Sans Medium | Kerning: Auto
Tracking: 0 | Case: Sentence

Do not size the logo smaller than the minimum sizes shown on the right for print and digital media.

Notes:

- Prioritize the use of horizontal logos for visibility, use vertical only if space is limited.
- The **x-height** is the distance between the baseline and the top line of the lowercase letters.


Clear Space & Minimum Size (continued)

Endorsement without icon type.

1. Always maintain a minimum clear space equal to 65% of the x-height of the logo around the endorsement lock-up.

Tracking: 0 | Case: Sentence



Placement

1. Use this placement guide for communications where SmartThings endorses another Samsung product.
2. Use corner placement in communications where there is a large key message or key image which takes priority.
3. Size the lettermark equal to one column width.
4. When selecting the visual, ensure that there is enough space in the bottom corner for the logo.

Use endorsement lock-ups to indicate compatibility with the SmartThings ecosystem.


Please note that the use of the WWST logo is only allowed for devices that have successfully completed the WWST certification process.

Do Nots

- A** Do not create a lock-up with the lettermark.
- B** Do not change the typeface of the endorsement line.
- C** Do not stack SmartThings differently.
- D** Do not alter the size of the endorsement line.
- E** Do not violate the spacing rule.
- F** Do not change the color of the endorsement lock-up.
- G** Do not alter the proportions of the icon and lock-up.
- H** Do not add drop shadows.
- I** Do not place the logo on busy backgrounds with insufficient contrast.

Badges

Endorsement without icon type.

1. Use endorsement badges for product packaging and services that meet SmartThings criteria for compatibility and support.

Use endorsement badges especially when:

- other endorsing brands appear in the same communication.
- a third party requires our endorsement.

2. “Works with” lock-ups can be used for both Samsung and third party packaging.

Do not apply any other colors for the logo.

Note: Prioritize the use of horizontal logos for visibility, use vertical only if space is limited.

Badges (continued)

Colors:

1. Badges can have a white or black background to increase versatility.
2. When selecting between the two color options, consider the contrast with the background and the overall color scheme.

Badge background

White version

CMYK: 0 0 0 0

HEX: #FFFFFF

Black version

CMYK: 0 0 0 100

HEX: #000000

Gray outline color

Stroke aligns inside the badge edge.

CMYK: 0 0 0 30

HEX: #B2B2B2

Note: Use process colors (CMYK) for print applications and HEX values for on-screen applications.

Specification:



1. The internal badge margins are shown on the right. Use the x-height to determine spacing and alignment. The x-height is the distance between the character baseline and the imaginary mean line that marks the tops of lowercase letters.

Line weight: Equal to 11.5% of the x-height

Round corner radius: Equal to 82% of the x-height

2. Top and bottom margins are 80% of the x-height, while left and right margins are 100% of x.
3. Always maintain a minimum clear space equal to 65% of the x-height of the logo around the endorsement badge.

Do not size the logo smaller than the minimum sizes shown on the left for print and digital media.


1. Always maintain a minimum clear space equal to 65% of the x-height of the logo around the endorsement lock-up.

SmartThings x x-height

The **x-height** is the distance between the baseline and the top line of the lowercase letters.



Badges Do Nots

- A** Do not put the lettermark inside the badge.
- B** Do not change the color of the badge.
- C** Do not recreate art for the logo.
- D** Do not put the endorsement line outside the badge.
- E** Do not switch the position of lock-up and icon.
- F** Do not create a new format for the badge frame.
- G** Do not change the color of the lock-up.
- H** Do not change the proportions of the badge or rearrange elements.
- I** Do not add drop shadows.
