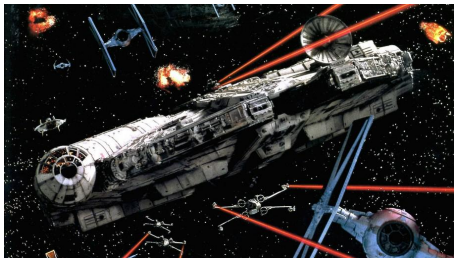

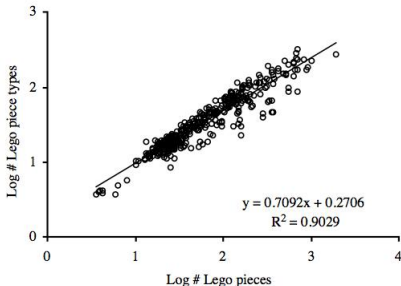
- Corellian YT-1300f Light Freighter

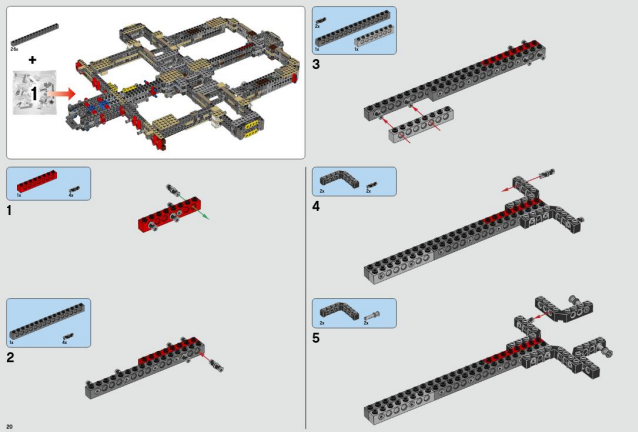

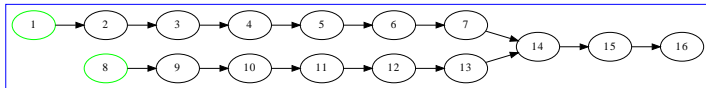
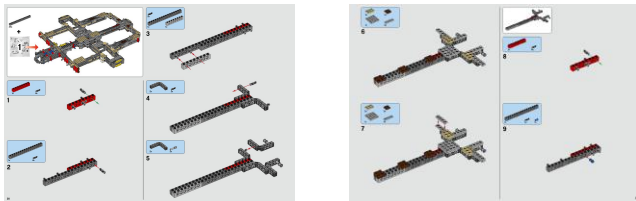

# Anatomy of A Lego Instruction

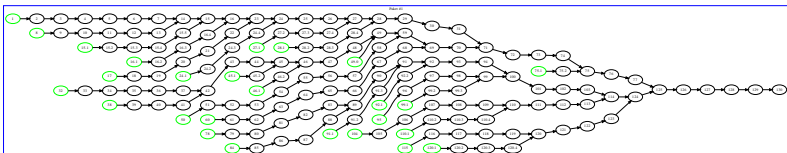

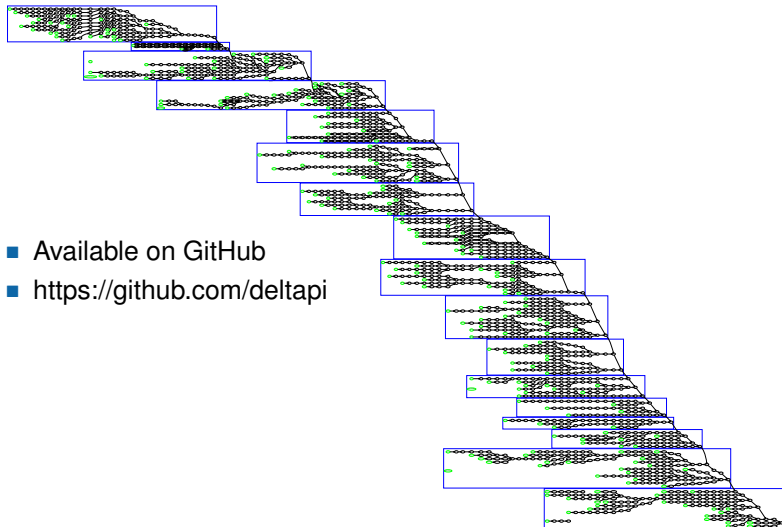
- Dependency graph for package 1:

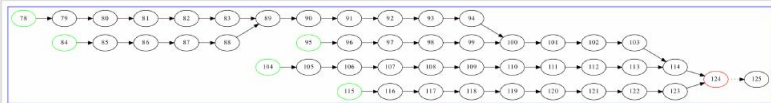
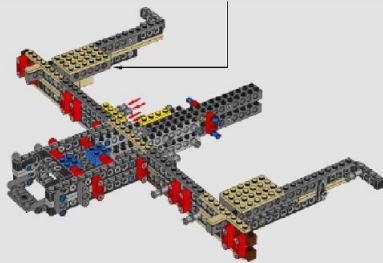

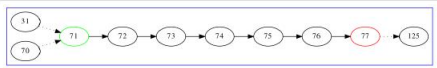

- Shared retrospective, planning etc.

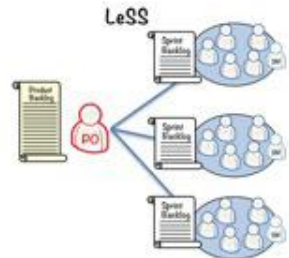
