



Evening and Weekend Programs Questions and Answers

Q: Why are Evening and Weekend Programs being discontinued?

A: Graduate School USA (GSUSA) recently applied for accreditation with the Accrediting Council for Continuing Education and Training (ACCET). In pursuit of the accreditation, GSUSA will be amending our Evening and Weekend Programs curriculum to ensure consistency and compliance with ACCET requirements. As we make these transformations, we are discontinuing Evening and Weekend Programs, as of June 24, 2019.

Q: What if I am enrolled in a certificate program?

A: Courses offered for the Spring 2019 term will be the last courses offered for the Evening Program. If you were enrolled in the Winter 2019 Term, and you have completed 50 percent or more of the courses required to complete your certificate, please [click here](#) to download and complete the attached information form.

Q: What if I enrolled in courses for the Summer 2019 Term?

A: All students who enrolled in courses offered in Summer 2019 will receive a full refund. Refunds will be processed and issued within 15 days.

Q: How do I get copies of my transcripts from Evening Programs?

Q: Are there any plans for a new program?

A: We expect to reimagine a continuing education program that addresses the current and emerging training needs beyond our traditional government core market, and offers more flexible delivery platforms for those learners.



Q: Will there be any Evening and Weekend courses that will continue?

A: The courses and the certificate program in Natural History Field Studies (“NATH”), offered by GSUSA in conjunction with the Audubon Naturalist Society of the Central Atlantic States, Inc., are not affected by this decision and will continue.

Q: Will discontinuing Evening and Weekend courses impact the daytime programs?

A: The changes taking place in Evening and Weekend Programs will have no impact on daytime Government Training and Professional Development courses and programs.
