## Fast and easy prescription transfers

Need to transfer prescriptions from another pharmacy? Now you can do it online with just a few clicks. Here's how:

- **Go to [Caremark.com/MoveMyMeds](https://www.caremark.com/MoveMyMeds) and enter your Member ID (found on your Member ID card).**
- **Then select your medications and we'll transfer them for you – it's that simple!**



\*At this time, orders for non-prescription items must be placed by phone. They cannot be placed through the CVS app.  
\*\*Orders must be placed by 4 p.m. or four hours before pharmacy closing, whichever is earlier, to ensure delivery within same day. Orders placed after the delivery cutoff time will be delivered the next day. Subject to extenuating factors, delivery time is anticipated to be within four hours of orders being placed. Delivery is limited to certain locations within a 10-mile radius of CVS Pharmacy locations, and as allowed by and in accordance with state guidelines and regulations. Delivery is provided at a special rate as part of your prescription benefit plan. If your plan requires you to pay a fee, you'll be notified of the fee before you prepay for your delivery order. Members must be home to accept the delivery. Certain medications cannot be delivered, such as controlled substances, medications that need refrigeration, and medications that are covered by Medicare Part B.
