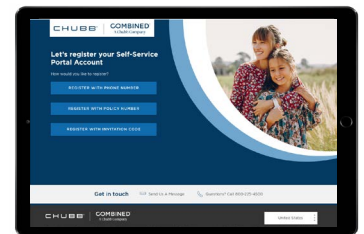

Begin registration by locating your account.

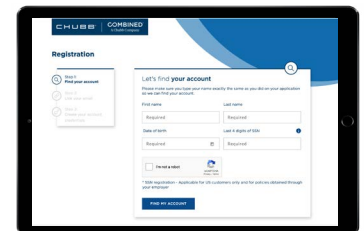
Simply click here, or scan the QR code to the right.



Step 2

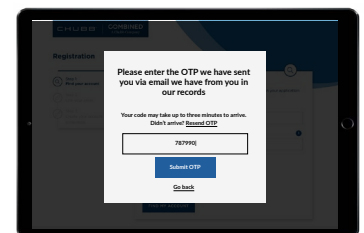
Next, we'll find your account.

Registration is one and done

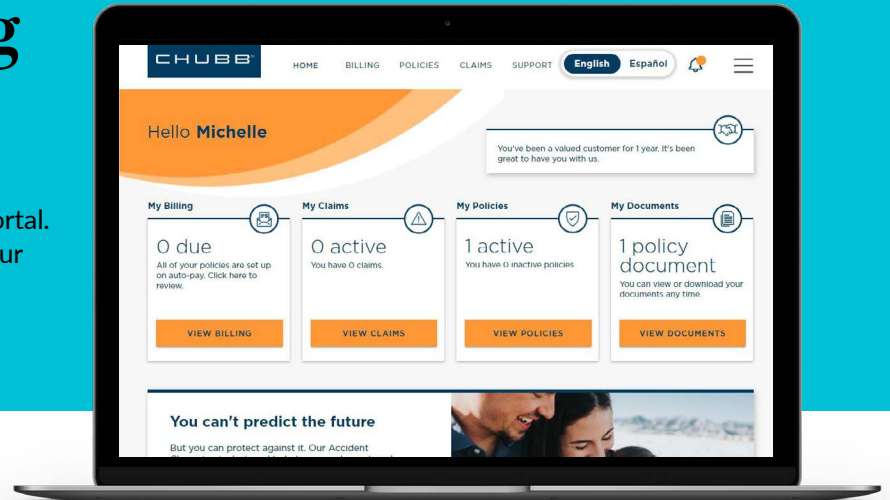
This process is only required for your **initial registration** in the self-service portal.

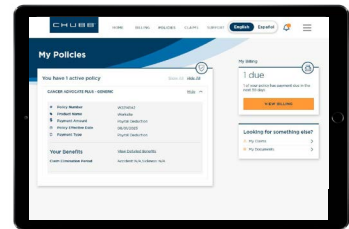
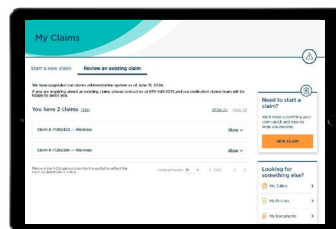
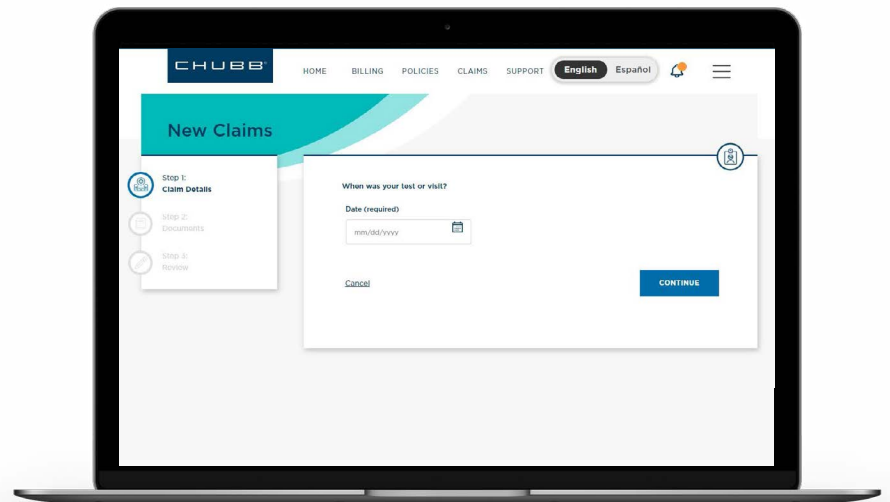
