

Can you feel it – the magic of the first snow? As the mountains sparkle and the crisp winter air hints at adventure, so the Tschuggen Grand Hotel's extraordinary annual Private Mountain begins: three days that belong just to us, alive with style, soul and unforgettable moments.

Private Mountain is exclusivity distilled. On Friday 28 November, a full day before the official opening, the slopes are ours alone: your chance to carve tracks across freshly groomed snow, no crowds, no queues. (Snow is, of course, guaranteed.) The mountain offers experiences found only here, only today: skiing with Olympic champion Tina Maze, a thrilling Synchron Speed Run race, or snow boccia for those who delight in play both on and off the piste.

This year's winter opening theme, "Alpine Elegance – Ski & Style", is woven through every part of the programme – not least thanks to the two cabins of the Urdenbahn aerial tramway, reimagined as extraordinary immersive experiences for the duration of the event. The first is a Porsche lounge featuring hot chocolate, fine desserts, a race simulator and virtual mountain drives - set against a showcase of exclusive Taycan models from Porsche Zentrum Maienfeld, displayed at the hotel entrance and the Hörnli lift; the second is a floating spa complete with hand massages, beauty products, fine desserts and hot drinks designed to leave you on cloud nine.

"Alpine Elegance – Ski & Style" lives up to the latter part of its name with glittering fashion showcases by jewellery house Zaugg and label Frauenschuh from Boutique Jelen, who will present their latest collections. Dinner on 28 November opens with an aperitif that's quite literally sparkling in style. Hidden in every glass of champagne is a diamond – all masterfully cut, but only one genuine. A gemmologist will examine the stones live and announce the winner of the treasure.

In short, Private Mountain is an event not to be missed. With three days rich in style, sport and soul, it's an opening that will set the winter season off in truly extraordinary fashion.




