Along the way, alpine villages like Livigno, Bormio and Arabba invite you to pause awhile – for a cappuccino with a view or a leisurely lunch of local specialities.

And yes, St. Moritz also knows a thing or two about Olympic glory. In 1928, the 50-kilometre cross-country

race got underway in a biting -30°C chill; the Finnish winner, wearing ski goggles and sporting a full beard, cut an almost unrecognisable figure. Later, in 1948, St. Moritz became a symbol of post-war reconciliation, hosting legendary downhill runs on the Piz Nair and historic bobsleigh races on natural ice.

Cortina is now set to write the next chapter in alpine history – with ski stars on steep slopes, electric ice hockey clashes and curling with a flair all its own. It promises sporting tradition, timeless style and more than a touch of nostalgia – all within reach of your winter residence at the luxurious Carlton Hotel St. Moritz.
