Race for Nature

A race to protect our natural world

As the centenary of the Tschuggen Collection, 2023 was and continues to be a very special year. The Tschuggen Collection – which comprises the Tschuggen Grand Hotel along with its three sister hotels, the Valsana Hotel in Arosa, the Carlton Hotel in St. Moritz and the Hotel Eden Roc in Ascona – is proud to be the first premium hotel group in Switzerland to go completely climate-neutral. With this in mind, it seemed only natural that our anniversary celebrations should also point the way – by taking further steps to protect our wonderful natural world. Ably supported by skiing legends such as Didier Cuche, Mauro Caviezel, Maria Walliser Anesini, Erika Raymond-Hess and Brigitte Oertli, 16 forward-thinking companies contested a ski race last March in favour of 16 hand-picked conservation organisations. The result? Memories we never

tire of reliving – and donations totalling over CHF 355,000 for various climate protection projects. We're thrilled to watch their hard work bear fruit! While the Green Advance Foundation set about building the world's largest 'flower butterfly' as a new home for bee species, the Swiss Parks Network ran the second edition of its campaign for free public transport to and from Swiss parks and the Bergwald ('Mountain Forest') Project prepared the forests of Trin for the Swiss winter with the help of donations and hard-working helpers. Perhaps dearest to our hearts is the 'There-for-trees' initiative in collaboration with Arosa forest authorities, whose outreach programmes for schools have made it possible for even the youngest children to visit the forests and learn more about the forest ecosystem, climate, biodiversity and sustainability. Once again, a heartfelt "**Merci!**" to all involved!
