Clarification Note

Following my letter dated 25 September, it should be noted for the avoidance of doubt, the Variation of Consent 2018 was first made on 1st February 2018 by Ecotricity (Next Generation) Ltd of Lion House, Rowcroft, Stroud, Gloucestershire, England, GL5 3BY ("the Applicant").

The Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS - the appropriate authority), requested an update to the Environmental Statement before the application could be published (23rd February 2018). The requirements of this were confirmed between Ecotricity and BEIS in correspondence dated 23rd March and 3rd April. The updated ES was submitted to BEIS on 11th May and approved for publication on 12 June. The associated correspondence is attached for your reference.
