Bach MS Orchestra – 4:00 p.m. Mrs. Margaret Brown, Conductor



MARGARET BROWN is in the third year of her second career as Adjunct Assistant Music Professor at UT Arlington. She serves in the String Music Education Department and as University Supervisor of Music Education Clinical Teachers. Serving as the Sigma Alpha Iota faculty advisor has been a highlight of this time at UTA. Ms. Brown joined the UTA faculty in 2020, after retiring from 34 years as a public-school teacher at high schools and middle schools in the Grand Prairie, Tyler, Lubbock and McKinney Independent School Districts. Ms. Brown had earned a Bachelor of Music Education from Texas Wesleyan University, where she studied with Dr. Robert McCashin. While in Lubbock, she added a Master of Music degree from Texas Tech University, studying with Dr. Virginia Kellogg. Ms. Brown served for two years as an Adjunct Music Professor at Texas Tech and as the Master Teacher for the Texas Tech String Project. She also was Conductor of the Lubbock Youth Symphony String Orchestra. As Director of Orchestras at both Irons Junior High and McKinney North High School, Ms. Brown quickly grew those into University Interscholastic League Sweepstakes Award-winning programs that included chamber music and full orchestras. She also instituted monthly Chamber Music Nights at McKinney North. At UTA, she continues to serve as the Camp Director of the Summer Strings Camp for middle and high school students and performed in the Texas Conducting Workshop. For five years, Ms. Brown served on the Executive Board of the Texas Orchestra Directors Association, including one year as president. She also was President and Treasurer of the Texas American String Teachers Association, and Secretary and Orchestra Chair for the Texas Music Educators Association Region 16. She is an active adjudicator for the Texas Music Adjudicators Association and a conductor and clinician for All-Region orchestras and orchestras across Texas. Her other memberships include Mu Omicron and Sigma Alpha Iota, a professional fraternity for women in the field of music. Ms. Brown has been honored and included in “Who’s Who Among American Women,” “Who’s Who Among America’s Teachers,” “Who’s Who in Music,” and “Who’s Who Among American High School Students.” She is proud of her designation as PTA Lifetime Membership Honoree.

Beethoven MS Orchestra – 4:30 p.m. Mr. Sean Carlton, Conductor



SEAN CARLTON is a cellist and music educator who grew up in Carrollton and Allen, Texas before attending Hardin-Simmons University in Abilene, Texas. There, he received his Bachelor of Music Degree in Music Education in 2012. While at Hardin-Simmons, Sean was a performing artist at the 2012 Honors and Awards Recital, the performing artist at the 2012 Commencement Ceremonies, and the recipient of the 2012 Education Deans of Independent Colleges and Universities of Texas Preservice Educator of the Year Award. Sean started his professional career as the director of orchestras for Madison Middle School in Abilene, Texas from 2012 to 2014. While in Abilene he also performed in pit orchestras for the Abilene Opera Association and Abilene Summer Musicals. Sean then served at Newman Smith High School from 2014 to 2018; first as the assistant director of orchestras, then the head director and fine arts department chair at Newman Smith. As a guest conductor, Sean has led the Abilene All City Orchestra, the Arkansas South Zone All Region Middle School Full Orchestra, and the Region 17 Middle School Full Orchestra. Sean has been a sought-after clinician to help prepare orchestras of all levels in preparation for UIL Concert and Sight-Reading Evaluation across the state. Sean Carlton is currently the assistant director of orchestras for Seven Lakes High School in Katy, Texas, and has led both non-varsity and varsity groups in concerts and evaluations, including a performance of the Seven Lakes High School Symphony Orchestra at the 2020 TMEA Honor Full Orchestra, numerous Mark of Excellence awards from The Foundation for Music Education, and distinctions from the American Prize in orchestral performance. Sean lives in Houston, Texas with his wife Heather and two beautiful daughters Lily (9) and Julia (6).

MARGARET SELBY is the orchestra director and 2020-21 Teacher of the Year at Laing Middle School in Charleston, SC where she grew the program from 42 to over 200 students in five years. She was the 2022 Featured Clinician for the Orchestra Division of the Texas Music Educators Association (TMEA) and is a contributing author of *Rehearsing the Middle School Orchestra*, published by Meredith Music and distributed by GIA. She has conducted the West Virginia Junior All-State Orchestra and multiple regional orchestras across the southeast and has adjudicated orchestras in Las Vegas and South Carolina. Mrs. Selby has presented sessions for the Texas Orchestra Directors Association (TODA), the South Carolina Music Educators Association (SCMEA), co-presented at the ASTA National Conference (2012, 2020, 2021) and was a panelist at the 2019 Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago. She served as the President for the SCMEA Orchestra Division and is currently the SCMEA Orchestra Division Region 4 Representative. Mrs. Selby is the 2017-18 String Educator of the Year awarded by Southern String Supply. She earned degrees in Music Education and Cello Performance from the University of South Carolina, studying under Dr. Robert Jesselson. She has performed with the South Carolina Philharmonic, the Charleston Symphony, and regularly as a freelance cellist. She is also a registered Suzuki cello teacher. Mrs. Selby lives in Mt. Pleasant, SC with her husband and their two crazy teenagers. She enjoys running and sampling Charleston’s many amazing restaurants

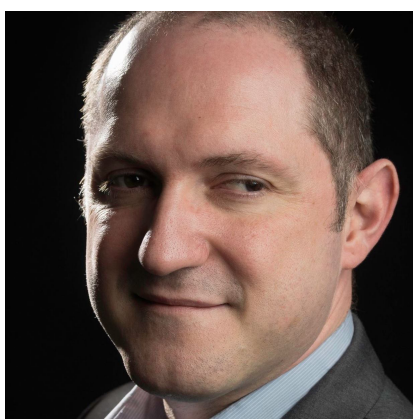
Philharmonic HS Orchestra – 5:30 p.m. Mrs. Jennifer Drake, Conductor

Jennifer is the Music Director of the Serenata Orchestra, the assistant conductor and principal violist for the Fairbanks Summer Arts Festival and the Music Director for the Boise Philharmonic Youth Orchestra. Jennifer is the principal violist for the Boise Baroque Chamber Orchestra, and a section violist for the Boise Philharmonic. Jennifer has enjoyed an international chamber music career, performing at the 33rd International Viola Congress in Iceland and the International Bass Clarinet Convention in Holland. DR. FRANK M. DIAZ is on faculty at the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. Before his appointment at IU, Dr. Diaz held appointments at the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music and Dance, the University of Oregon, and at school districts in New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Florida. He is also former Music Director and Conductor of the Corvallis Youth Symphony in Oregon. Dr. Diaz has served as a conductor, adjudicator, presenter, and clinician in over 30 states as well as internationally. Ensembles under his direction have performed at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, the National Association for Music Education, and at various conferences and honor festivals across the United States. At the university level, he has led orchestras at Indiana University, UMKC Conservatory, and Florida State University, and taught courses in instrumental music education, conducting, orchestral literature, and musicians' wellness. Dr. Diaz holds degrees in education, performance, and conducting from Florida State University and the University of South Florida and has been an active performer on trombone as well as electric and double bass in wind bands, orchestras, jazz ensembles, rock bands, Afro-Cuban ensembles, and various other groups throughout Florida, the Northeast, and the Pacific Northwest. He was born in Havana, Cuba and currently lives in Bloomington, Indiana with his wife, daughter, and three cats.

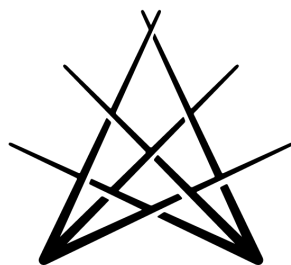
