



New User Registration

From www.gatewayfirst.com, click “Log in.”


Select Mortgage Account in the account type drop-down, then click “Log in”.

It will open: <https://mymortgageaccount.gatewayfirst.com/>





STEP 2

Complete the requested information, check the “I have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions” and click “register.” You will see a message advising to check your email.


