Initial Requirements

Prospective candidates must be employed in Leicestershire and Rutland Primary Care services and have the agreement of their manager to provide SDI procedures.

Contact the preferred training provider to confirm support and timescales for the practical training element

Complete CoSRH - Online Theory Assessment (OTA)
1 hour to complete 50 questions

E-learning for health eSRH course is helpful revision for the OTA

OTA £93 (per attempt) paid to the CoSRH.

On completion of the OTA, candidates will have 2 years to pass the practical training and apply for the LoC

Pass OTA assessment

Complete eLFH module 14

Complete practical training as below

Training Option 1

An Organon Faculty Registered Trainer will come to the trainees practice to provide practical skills, training and certify completion of the LoC.
The practice needs to arrange for 9 patients to attend the clinic on the day of training. 3 implant replacements 2 insertions and 4 removals
Provided free of charge to the trainee by a medical educational goods and service grant provided by Organon Ltd as a service to the NHS to maintain and improve patient care

Training Option 2

A LSRH Faculty Registered Trainer will come to the trainees practice to provide practical skills, training and certify completion of the LoC. The training includes model arm and live patient training.
The practice needs to arrange for 9 patients to attend the clinic on the day of training. 3 implant replacements 2 insertions and 4 removals

Training Option 3

Leicestershire & Rutland integrated sexual health service will provide practical skills training and certification of completion of the LoC with a faculty registered trainer. The training includes model arm and live patient training. This requires 1-2 sessions at the Loughborough Hub. An honorary contract with HCRG Care Group will need to be in place for this option

Obtain CoSRH associate membership **£121 per annum**

Apply for Letter of Competence Sub-Dermal Implants Insertion and Removal (LoC SDI IR) on CoSRH website

Registering the LoC IUT is **£121** for associate members or **£505** to non-members

Recertification of the LoC SDI IR will be required every 5 years (free CoSRH to members)
