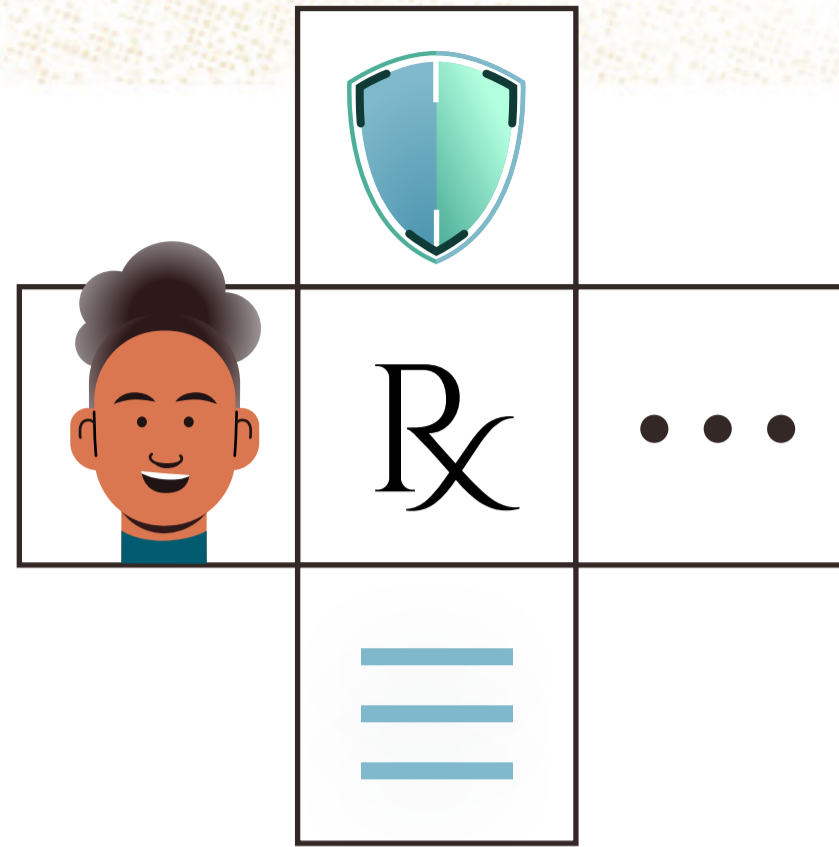


Filling a prescription sometimes involves prior authorization (PA).



Follow this checklist to navigate the PA process.

- Ask your provider if your new prescription requires PA.
- Call your insurance company to confirm the need for PA.
- Answer any questions from your provider's office that may help them provide needed information to the insurance company.
- If your prior authorization is denied, ask your provider about the appeals process.
- Visit the website for your medication to see if they offer any additional information.
- Once it's approved, fill your prescription at your pharmacy as usual.

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
