WIL Structure

ICHM offers a mix of both paid and unpaid Work Integrated Learning (WIL) opportunities.

If a student secures a paid position, they will be compensated according to the Australian National Employment Standards and any relevant industrial awards.

WIL Semester Duration	20 - 24 weeks
WIL Weekly Duration	up to 38 hours per week
Minimum Award Rate*	\$24.28 per hour
