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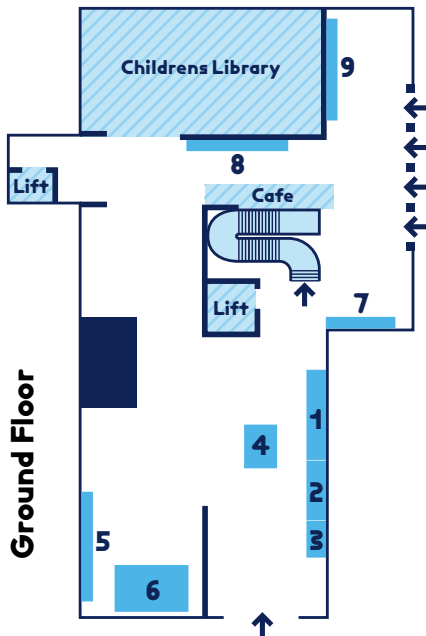

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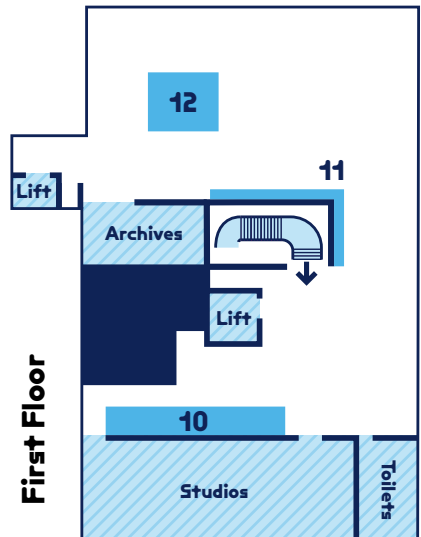
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Exhibition Guide



1. A timeline of Alan Boyson's life and career accompany Esther Johnson's striking images of the Merseyway Car Park Screen, designed by Alan Boyson in 1967.
2. Points & Planes, a new artist film by Esther Johnson, including powerful drone footage of the Merseyway Screen, and music from Boyson's own record collection.
3. Cloud #3, a sculptural piece made by Boyson in the 1970s from plywood, stainless steel & acrylic.
4. An original letter from Boyson to 'the other marvel from Marple', friend and collaborator Philip Andrew and CO OP ephemera designed by Boyson.
5. Two-part video on the living room screens:
Film 1: The Other Marvel From Marple, a conversation with architect Philip Andrew (17 mins)
Film 2: Alan Boyson: In Conversation with his son Matthew (4 mins)
6. Animated short film called Boyson Tile Boogie playing on the screens, along with colourful cubes showcasing many of Boyson's sponge-print tile designs.
7. Digitised objects from the archives at Stockport relating to Alan Boyson, Philip Andrew and the construction of the Merseyway.

8. Screens showcase archive footage from both Stockport and Hull relating to the construction of Boyson's large-scale works in both places.
9. Original sculptural pieces by Boyson including plates, ceramics, vases and even an owl sculpture. Selection of artwork, inspired by Boyson and the design of the Merseyway, including pieces by Alison Waters, Matthew Steele and Gary Andrew Clarke.
10. Exploration of Boyson's work across mediums, highlighting his versatility and talent working from large-scale public works, including pre-cast concrete (like the Merseyway Screen), murals and mosaics, to smaller sculptural pieces, tile, and fibreglass.
11. Timeline of Philip Andrew's life and work and development of the Merseyway from the 1930s to the present.
12. Original plans, blueprints & study books from and by Philip Andrew relating to the development of the Merseyway.
