

TEST BARN FLOW



Notification and Tagging

- HIWU-authorized Sample Collection Personnel (SCP) provides Nominated/Responsible Person (NP/RP) with Notice of Selection
- SCP documents time of notification




Arrival to Test Barn

- SCP documents arrival and verifies the ID of the NP/RP on the Test Barn Roster
- NP/RP acknowledges notification and their rights and responsibilities
- Confirm identity of Covered Horse upon arrival and throughout session
- Assign a clean water bucket to the horse and ensure Covered Horse remains under observation



Blood Collection

- Blood Collection Officer (BCO) prepares and performs blood draw on Covered Horse
- BCO or SCP labels blood tubes using Sample Code seals
- BCO or SCP scans Sample Code barcode
- BCO and/or SCP prints and signs their name(s) and keeps sample in a secure location



Hot-Walking

- Horse is Hot-Walked for at least 20 minutes to cool down and prepare for testing; SCP continuously observes



Urine Sample Collection

- SCP collects urine sample then immediately places lid on the collection cup
- SCP splits urine into 2 bottles and applies Sample Code seals
- SCP scans Sample Code seals
- SCP prints and signs their name(s) and puts the sample into an individually sealed specimen bag



Sample Collection Form Review

- Collection Officer or BCO reviews Sample Collection Documentation with the NP/RP to ensure the data is accurate.
- All parties print and sign acknowledgement



- The Sample Collection Session is now complete and the Covered Horse is released and signed out of Test Barn.
