

Guide to Billing Process for Testing Fees



This resource is available to help Covered Persons understand the billing process and fees for testing services under HISA rules.

Vets' List Testing

- First Vets' List test is no cost
- Billed for 2nd or subsequent Vets' List test within a rolling 12-month period
- Billed to Designated Owner
- Cost: \$200.00

Claimed Horse Testing

- Can be requested as part of the claiming process
- Billed to Designated Owner
- Cost: \$225.00 (if applicable)
- If claim is voided, claiming party who requested the test is not charged

Billing Process

- All test services invoices are billed for payment through the HISA portal.
- The party responsible for payment of the test services invoice will receive an email notification with the subject line, "New Test Service Invoice". A link within the email will direct them to the HISA Portal to pay the invoice.
- Upon successful payment of your test services invoice, you will receive an email with the subject line, "HISA Portal Update," and will provide details of your payment.

Vets' List

Rule 3132. Authority to test (e) In accordance with the Racetrack Safety Program, a Covered Horse may be required to submit to Sample collection (at the Owner's cost) following a Vets' List Workout in order to be released from the Veterinarians' List.

Claimed Test

Rule 3060. Claiming Races and voidable claims (a) Subject to Rule 3132(b), a claimed horse may be subject to Sample collection at a Claiming Race if requested (and paid for) by the claimant as part of the claiming procedure on the day of the Claim.
