Legislative Advocacy

Engaging directly with law makers to influence the development, revision, or repealing of laws.

Primary Methods:

- Lobbying
- Providing testimony at hearings
- Writing and sharing policy briefs, factsheets, white papers, etc.
- Drafting bill language
- Attending advocacy days and legislative visits

Separate from legislation, engaging with local lawmakers can have a large impact.

- Acquaint them with your work, successes and challenges.
- Establish a relationship with so that future interactions and lobby can be successful.
