Community or Grassroots Advocacy

Mobilizing and organizing community members to advocate for policies that address the issues that affect them.

Primary methods include:

- Attend or hold community forms to discuss issues with residents and create solutions.
- Neighborhood canvassing to engage and inform community members.
- Teaching advocacy skills such as providing testimony or writing letters.
- Organizing community-led projects through local initiatives or actions.
