Consider reflecting upon the parable of the Good Samaritan

(Luke 10:25-37)

This parable demonstrates to us how we can be a good neighbour to homeless people in our communities. It's difficult to know what to do when you notice more people sleeping rough than ever before.

In the story of the Good Samaritan, a man took it upon himself not to walk away.

He bandaged the traveller's wounds, took him to an inn and looked after him.

The traveller in The Good Samaritan did not intend to get himself injured. Similarly, no one thinks that one day, they'll be homeless.

But for **11,000 households in Scotland**, this is their reality. They are stuck in temporary accommodation without a place to call their own. This is because the system has failed them. Shelter Scotland are here to get them back to a good place.
