As one of your constituents I would like to ask you to support Shelter Scotland's **#Buildscotlandsfuture** campaign to pledge to build **at least 37,100 homes for social rent** over the next 5 years (2021 – 2026). This number of homes is the level of building required to begin to reduce housing need in Scotland.

The Scottish Government has committed to build a record number of social homes over the current parliament but it's not enough to meet the arising or backlog of demand. An ambitious new affordable house building programme can deliver this social housing, but this will take leadership, investment and long-term commitment from the Scottish Government to make this a reality.

Put another way, over the next five years, in addition to the current target - Scotland must commit to building just one extra home for social rent a day, compared to the current number of homes being built, to start reducing Scotland's housing needs.

By building more homes, we can help rebuild Scotland's economy, rebuild our communities, create more jobs, help meet climate and child poverty targets and build a brighter future. That's why we're calling on all political parties to build more social homes.

Despite record levels of investment in building more affordable housing over the last four years, waiting lists remain high and homelessness is again on the rise. The latest figures show that there were around 130,000 households on a waiting list for

social housing in Scotland, over 14,000 households were in temporary accommodation, these households spending over six months on average in this kind of accommodation.

Homelessness and a lack of housing is not inevitable, building more social housing will help to reduce housing need, where it is needed, for the people that need it most.
