Interview with one of our Shelter advisers

How long have you worked at Shelter?

My name's Stan and I've worked at Shelter for over two years. I am an adviser in our London Hub. I advise and support people who are facing all manner of housing problems.

Can you tell us about a memorable case that you've worked on?

Advisers challenge local authorities when they refuse to help homeless families, despite legal duties to do so. Recently we helped a family who had been sleeping in a car for three nights before we intervened and helped them secure a safe and suitable place to live.

What would happen if Shelter didn't exist?

Fewer people would have a safe place to call home. Homelessness is on the increase and more people are at risk of eviction, Shelter needs to fight harder than ever to help

people through difficult moments in their lives. We can only do this with your support.
