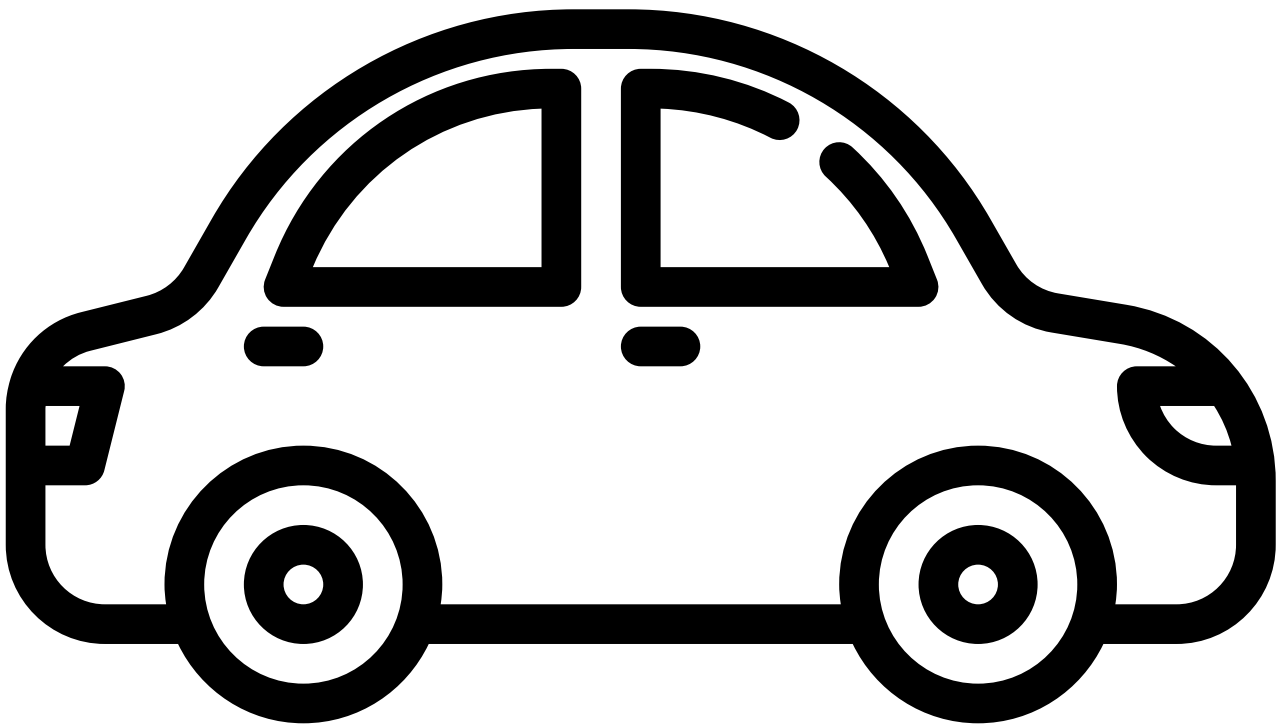


Design a shelter for...

You are a family of 3 living in one room. You don't have any cooking facilities or food storage. You have your own bathroom and a kettle.

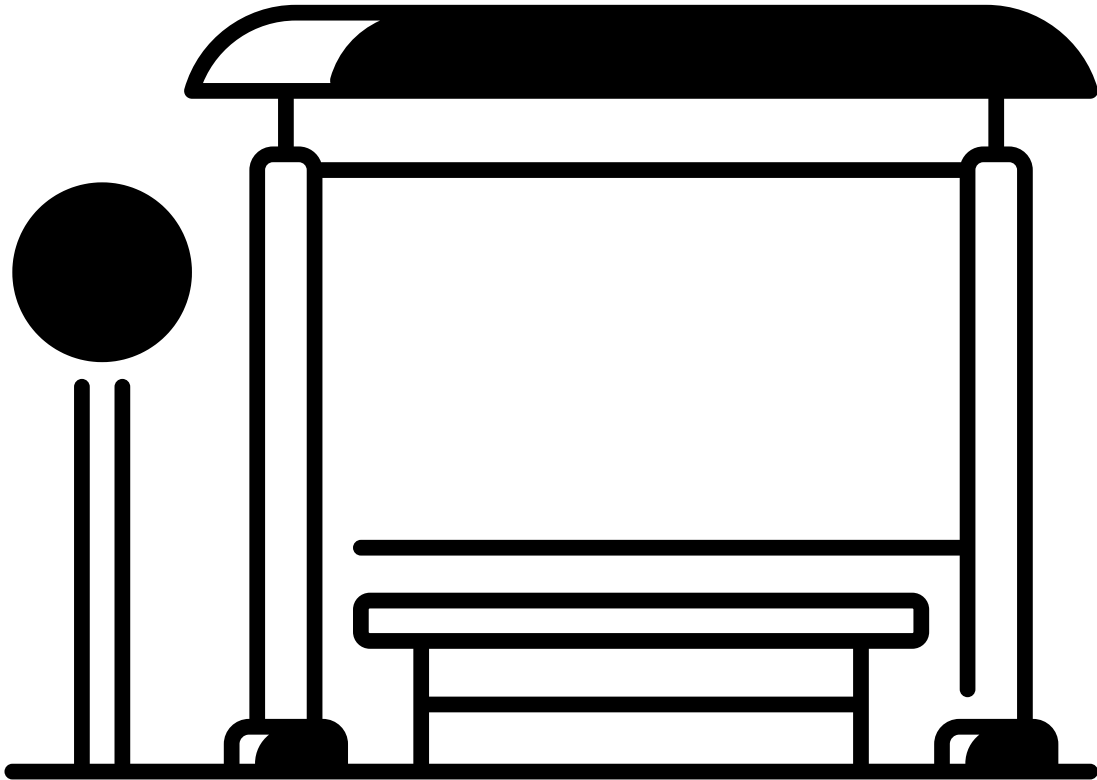
- How will you store and make food?

Prompts:

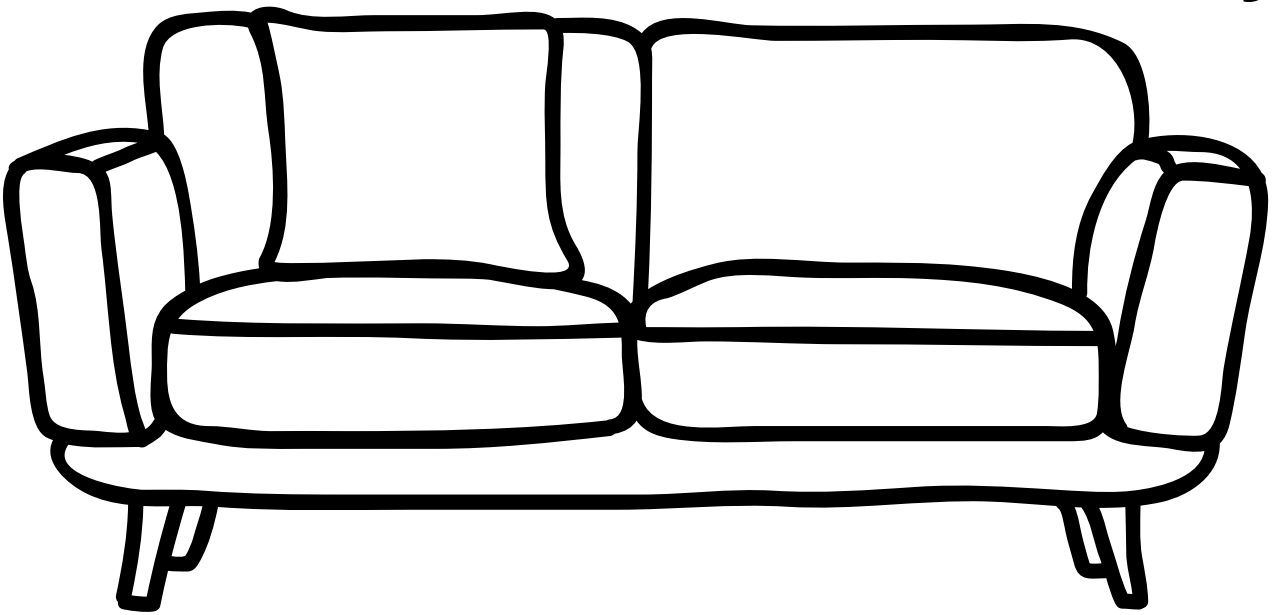
- How will you store and make food?
