What we do

Our direct services are designed to advise, guide and support people with all types of housing needs – whether it takes a short conversation or intensive support over several months. We work together with the local community to make sure that the services we offer reflect local needs.



STAR Partnership and London Youth Gateway

Pan-London advice and support on housing and homelessness to those over 25 (STAR Partnership) and under 25 (London Youth Gateway).



Legal Advice Service

Legal advice relating to housing and homelessness, including legal aid, representation in court and claims against landlords.



DIY Skills Service

Funded by B&Q, the service not only supports people to do practical things like painting, basic electrics and woodwork to improve their home, but also to use existing and acquire new skills in DIY.



Southwark Service

Housing advice and support delivered by the Shelter team in Southwark.

Homelessness Prevention

Partnership prevention service delivered with Westminster City Council and The Passage in Westminster.



North Kensington Team

Set up in response to the fire at Grenfell Tower, a community-based housing advice and support service for residents in the borough of Kensington and Chelsea.

Newham Housing Action Team

A 12 month pilot building on our work in the borough and our existing family services aimed at women and children currently unable to access safe accommodation. The voices of women and children experiencing destitution and unsafe housing shape the team and we work with partners to achieve systems change.
