A letter is being drafted to send to property owners in the PPUABA area regarding the problem and identifying how to recognize the signs of infestation and resources for addressing it.

There have been many reports of missing packages for all the delivery services. While there is no universal solution, suggestions are to sign up for the [myUPS](#) app to be able to see exactly when UPS delivers. Also, Duane Reade will receive FedEx packages for individuals.

Greenest Block Contest

Den Gordon has suggested that PPUABA participate in the yearly 'Greenest Block' competition as a way to involve more neighbors and build community. Den wants to apply for a PPUABA grant to fund some of the effort. A show of hands indicated there is interest. One issue is the continuing work on the new gas lines, new sewers, and the protective structures around the trees. As there is some time until the spring Gib Veconi will try to follow up and see when the sewer work will start. Also regarding work on the streets, Gib recommends taking a picture of your sidewalks before the city commences work.

Gib Veconi made a motion that we form a committee to investigate joining the Greenest Block Competition, with Den Gordon as chair. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously. People who are interested should contact Den Gordon.

Documenting our processes
