Overruns

Purpose URBN is obligated to purchase up to 5% over and above individual purchase orders, providing that merchandise is made available to us at the same time as the main shipment and style/color/size ratios are maintained.

Note: Supplier requires no special authorization to ship foregoing goods to us.

- **Schedule** To the extent that supplier has produced goods over and above this allowance, they must advise us, in which case, we may elect to negotiate the sale. Under no circumstances, however, are we obligated to accept such overages.
- **Procedure** The following steps should be followed should we decline to accept overages, contractor is obligated to:

Step	Action
1	Deface all main labels and remove all Urban Outfitters/Anthropologie/Free People identification from the product, except logo buttons, embroidered treatments, etc., which are not readily removable. Refer to the "Defacing of Labels on Non-Conforming Product" section.
2	Hold seasonal goods for 180 days beyond last ex- factory date for given style. Authorization to sell off merchandise must be in writing by the appropriate URBN product manager.
3	Garments must remain and be sold within the country of origin. Garments cannot be transshipped to another country for disposal
4	Once provisions of Step 3 have been met, supplier may dispose of goods without further notice.

Cancelled Orders

- **Purpose** The purpose of this procedure is to determine the appropriate actions to be taken, and the vendors prerogative to resell merchandise, when URBN exercises its right, under the terms of the Purchase Agreement, to cancel a purchase order prior to it having been shipped.
- **Schedule** As stated in the Terms of Purchase Agreement, URBN may cancel any PO by written notice to the vendor before the cancel date on the applicable PO. URBN may cancel all or any part of any undelivered order if URBN's business is discontinued or substantially impacted in whole or in part by a cause beyond URBN's reasonable control, such as fire, flood, earthquake, storm, unusually severe weather, labor dispute, war, embargo, civil commotion, or governmental act.
- **Procedure** The following steps should be followed should URBN cancel a purchase order, and the vendor elects to exercise their right to re-sell the merchandise. Vendor shall not sell, transfer, or otherwise dispose of any cancelled merchandise without URBN's express written agreement. The vendor is obligated to:

Step	Action
1	Deface all main labels and remove all Urban Outfitters/Anthropologie/Free People identification from the product, except logo buttons, embroidered treatments, etc., which are not readily removable. Refer to the "Defacing of Labels on Non-Conforming Product" section.
2	Hold seasonal goods for 180 days beyond last ex- factory date for given style. Authorization to sell off merchandise must be in writing by the appropriate URBN product manager.
3	Garments must remain and be sold within the country of origin. Garments cannot be transshipped to another country for re-sale
4	Once provisions of Step 3 have been met, supplier may proceed with the off-price sale of the merchandise.

Irregular Goods

- **Purpose** The purpose of this procedure is to determine the appropriate actions to be taken when the inspection process discovers irregular merchandise.
- **Schedule** The procedure should be followed any time irregular merchandise is discovered through the inspection process.
- **Procedure** Comply with the following steps to determine the appropriate action for handling irregular goods:

Goods Received in our Distribution Center which Fail Quality Assurance

Purpose	The purpose of this procedure is to determine the appropriate action taken when goods are received in URBN Distribution Center and fails our internal audit.
Schedule	This procedure should be followed any time a shipment fails.

Procedure Orders will be either returned to the supplier or sent to a pre-determined designated location in the United States within two working days, freight collect. **URBN is not in the business of selling off seconds to discounters.**

Step	Action
1	Once a shipment fails inspection, suppliers will be notified of the problems accompanied by inspection reports, digital photographs and/or samples.
2	Chargebacks will be issued for the full Landed Duty Paid value.
3	Goods will be packed and scheduled to be shipped from our Distribution Center within 48 hours. It will be the suppliers decision to either 1.) Have the goods returned to them or 2.) Sent to a predetermined location in the United States. If option 2 is taken, follow the Irregular Goods procedure and Overruns steps 1 & 2.

The procedures outlined in this document apply to Ownbrand vendors only. Market vendors are to refer to the Terms of Purchase Agreement.

The attached Overruns, Cancelled orders, Irregulars, and Orders Failing Internal Quality Assurance Procedure document describes important information about URBN and I understand that I should consult a representative of the URBN production staff regarding any questions not answered in the document.

URBN, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to change or delete any of these procedures as it sees fit. All such changes will be communicated through official notices, and I understand that revised information may supersede, modify, or eliminate existing procedures.

Furthermore, I acknowledge that this document is for informational purposes only. It is not a contract and does not create any contractual right or agreement between URBN and the company represented by myself.

I have received URBN Overruns, Cancelled Orders, Irregulars, and Orders Failing Internal Quality Assurance Procedure document, and I understand that it is my responsibility to read and comply with the procedures herein and any revisions made to it.

Upon internal quality assurance failure of goods received, URBN must be informed of location to ship the goods to within <u>48 hours</u>.
