

# Arrival and departure information



**Dear guest,**

Just like you, we're counting down the days until we meet on board and sail the world's most beautiful voyage. In this document, you'll find key information about flights and transfers to ensure your arrival and departure goes as smoothly as possible.

Our arrival and departure package includes most transfers in Bergen, Kirkenes, Trondheim and Oslo. If we cannot provide a suitable transfer, Hurtigruten will inform you before your journey. If your booking includes transfers, your travel documents contain the required vouchers. Please present the applicable transfer voucher to the bus driver.

Transfers are usually unaccompanied and operated by a charter bus (fixed times) or an airport express

bus (official schedule). The fixed times align with your ship's arrival. Therefore, waiting times at the airport may occur. Please note: Transfers outside our scheduled transfers must be arranged independently and at your own expense. If your booking doesn't include any transfers, you can still book transfers outlined in this document.

For more information, please refer to your booking confirmation. You can also visit relevant websites by clicking the underlined text in this document. What's more, clicking on a map will open an A4 version that you can download or print.

# Flights

We've put together a short guide to flying to Norway, including information on luggage and check-in processes.

## Check-in

Depending on your airline, you may be able to check in online, at a self-service kiosk at the airport, or in-person at the airport. We recommend checking in via the airline's website or app before travelling to the airport. You can log in to the airline's website or app with your flight reference number, which is located on your booking confirmation. Once logged in, you can also order special services like meals, wheelchairs or seat reservations. Available services depend on the airline. Please note: Your flight tickets are digital. No paper copies are sent.

## Codeshare flights

A codeshare is an arrangement where

two or more airlines market a flight as their own, but only one carrier operates the flight. Therefore, your flight may be operated by a different carrier than the one shown on your itinerary.

## Gate changes

We recommend arriving at the airport at least two hours before departure to check in any luggage and pass through security. Due to possible gate changes, please double-check your gate number at the transfer desk, listen for announcements and check the arrival/departure board.

## Checked luggage

Your checked luggage is available to collect at your final destination. However, please speak with the airline or check-in staff if your journey consists of multiple flights with different airlines and you have separate tickets per flight. In this scenario, it's usually not possible

for checked luggage to travel directly to your final destination.

Your checked luggage is usually restricted to one piece weighing up to 23 kg. Any excess luggage must be paid upon check-in or pre-paid on the airline's website, which might be cheaper than paying at the airport. Any single piece of luggage weighing over 32 kgs will not be accepted.

We also recommend retaining the luggage tag issued at check-in until after you have collected your luggage.

## Hand luggage

Generally, one piece of hand luggage can be brought on board the plane. You can take your hand luggage directly to the gate mentioned in your boarding pass, even if you have a connecting flight to Norway and/or an onward flight to another destination in Norway.

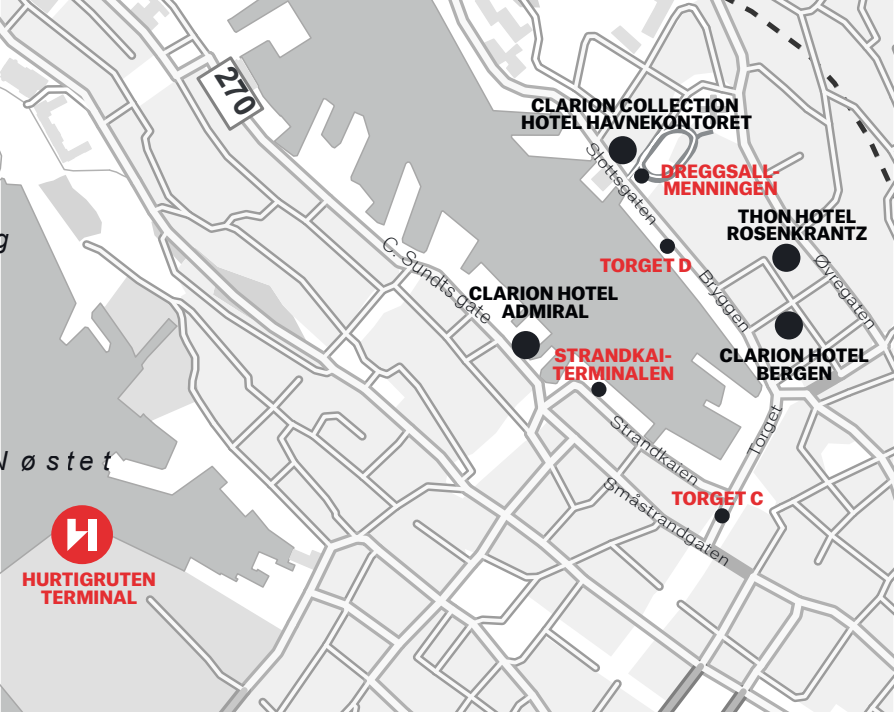

# Bergen transfers



## JEKTEVIKSTERMINALEN / HURTIGRUTEN TERMINAL

Nøstegaten 30, 5010 Bergen  
Open daily 11:00-21:00

The Hurtigruten Guest Lounge is located on the second floor of the terminal and is open from 13:00.

In our guest lounge, you're welcome to enjoy light refreshments. Complimentary WIFI, USB chargers and sockets are also available.

Luggage lockers are available in the terminal in varying sizes and can be paid for by credit card. Our luggage service is open between 13:00-14:30.

The latest arrival time for guests is 30 minutes before the ship's departure.

**Check-in:** From 15:30  
**Boarding:** From 16:00  
**Cabins available:** From 18:00

The mandatory Safety Briefing is held before boarding in the Guest Lounge's Lecture Hall.

### Transfer information

Flybussen Bergen's service connects Bergen Flesland Airport and the city centre. The bus arrives and departs just outside the airport's terminal building and follows a route via Fyllingsdalen to Bergen Bus Station and the city centre.

It takes approximately 45 minutes to reach the Jekteviksterminalen/Hurtigruten Terminal from the airport and vice versa.

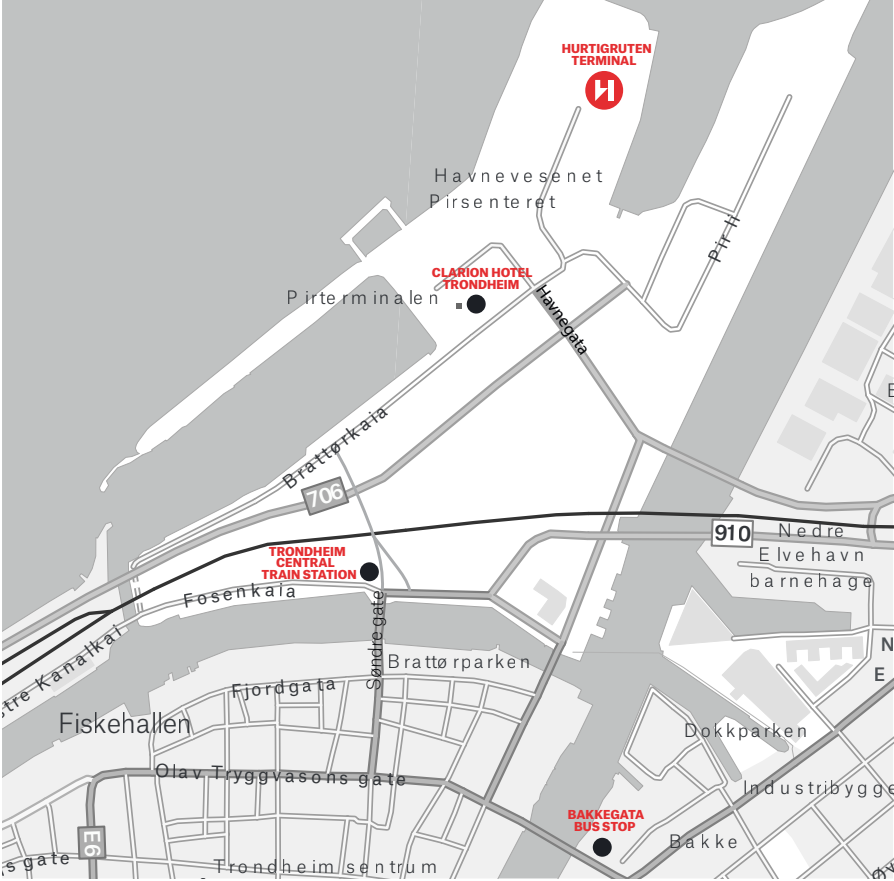

# Trondheim transfers



The Værnes-Ekspressen/Unibuss transfer bus connects the Trondheim Værnes Airport (bus stop A4) with the city centre (including hotels and train station) and the Hurtigruten Pier. It takes approximately 25-30 minutes to travel to/from the Hurtigruten Pier to the airport.

Please note that not all areas in the city are covered by the transfer bus. Bus stops for the main hotels are:

- Søndre gate: Trondheim Central Station and Clarion Congress Hotel.
- Bakkegata: Radisson BLU Royal Garden Hotel and Grand Olaf Hotel.

## Bergen and Trondheim: Private airport transfers for platinum guests

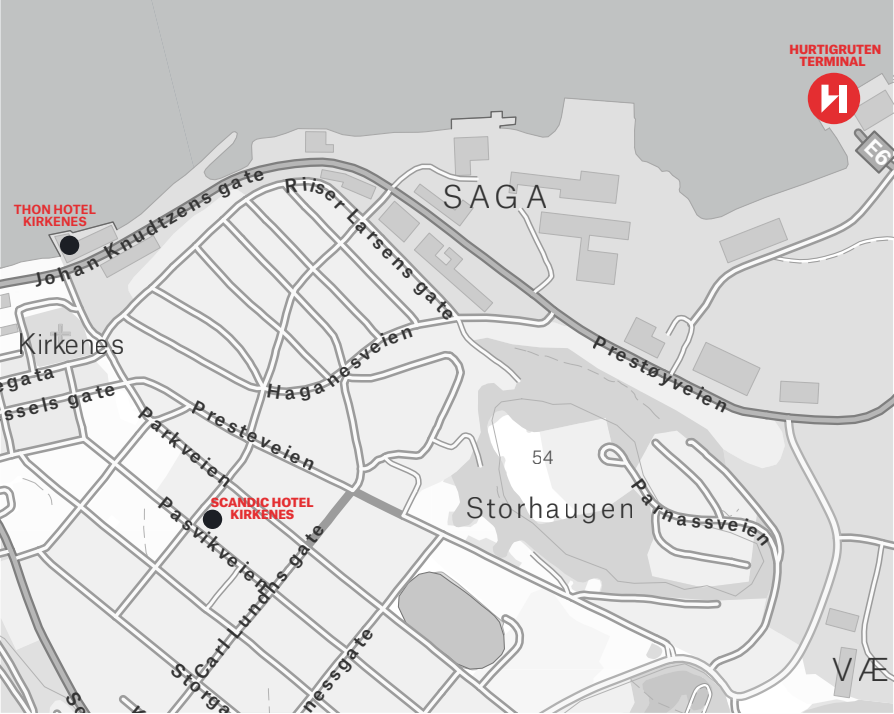
This service includes being met by an English-speaking driver who will transfer you with a private car or taxi to the Hurtigruten Terminal or your hotel in Bergen or Trondheim. Exclusively for Platinum guests travelling on a Hurtigruten Norwegian Classic Voyage. This transfer pick-up information also applies to guests using wheelchairs. Please note: Private transfers and wheelchair transfers can only be pre-booked.

**From Bergen or Trondheim airport:**  
Please look out for a Hurtigruten sign with your name in the airport's arrival hall. Your driver will then take you to the private car.

**From hotels in Bergen or Trondheim:**  
The pick-up time from the hotel will always be three hours before your flight's departure time. The driver will meet you in the hotel lobby.

**From Hurtigruten Terminal or Pier:**  
Please look out for a Hurtigruten sign with your name when leaving the ship. Your driver will then take you to the private car.

# Kirkenes transfers



The transfer bus is a Hurtigruten charter bus that departs from the airport and the Hurtigruten quay.

The transfer time is approximately 30 minutes.

**Please note:**

If there is a large number of passengers, there will be several buses departing to different destinations. Please ensure that you board the correct bus.

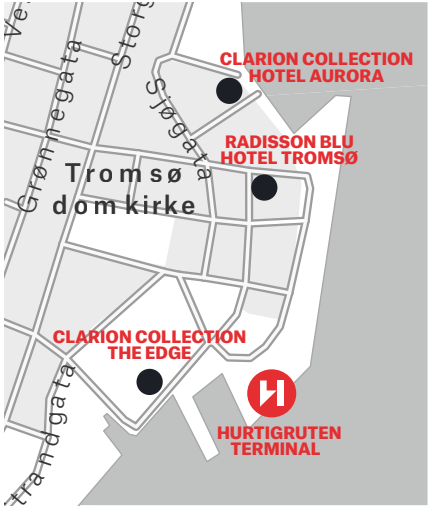

# Tromsø transfers

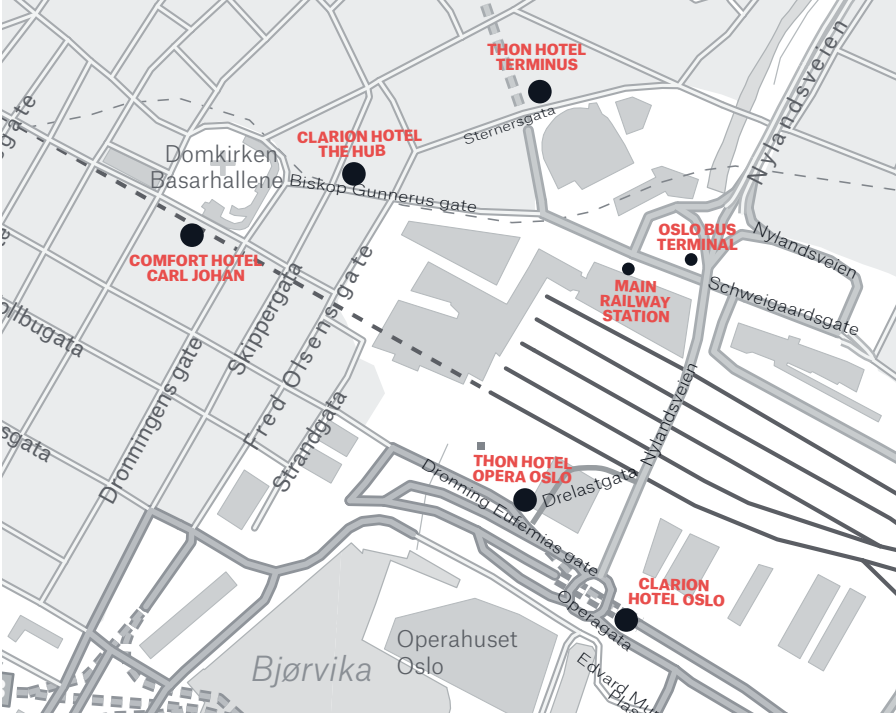
The official airport bus, Bussring, will take you to the city centre hotels. The timetable varies on weekends. Please look out for red busses that leave in front of the airport's arrival hall.
