Subject overview

This subject involves livestream case-based discussions and clinical placements at Endeavour's facilities. Students observe other student practitioners in consultations and participate in tutorials to understand clinical reasoning, decision-making, and point prescription formulation. They will use traditional theories, evidence-based knowledge, and client input to inform clinical decisions and reflect on their performance. Practical skills will be consolidated through performing Chinese remedial massage (tui na), and lifestyle therapies on model patients, adhering to clinical procedures and professional standards. Students will also act as clinical assistants, preparing for future placements as senior student practitioners.
