Subject overview

In Clinical Nutritional Skills 2, students prepare for the clinical practicum subjects. Students develop their ability to apply the Nutritional Case Management Process: nutrition focused case taking, nutritional health assessment, holistic nutritional diagnosis, nutritional treatment planning, monitoring and evaluation. This process is applied to case studies and client volunteers to integrate theoretical knowledge, clinical skills and cultural awareness, and to demonstrate reflective practice. Students will attend and be orientated to Endeavour Wellness Clinic policies and procedures.

As this subject builds into client-facing consultations, this subject requires the student to maintain 100% attendance across both the livestream and the on-campus timetabled classes for the full 12 weeks.
