Subject overview

This subject teaches students the theory and practical skills for clinical examination and assessment of the client using conventional medical diagnostic techniques with standard examination tools. Students are required to interpret the results of the clinical examination techniques performed. Students are required to practice examination procedures on each other in a supervised setting, learning appropriate regard for privacy and personal boundaries
