Subject overview

This subject prepares students for advanced professional practice by engaging them in specialised nutritional case-based learning that builds upon foundational clinical nutrition knowledge. It immerses students in complex, system-specific nutrition scenarios, covering gastroenterology, dermatology, reproductive health, immunology, and musculoskeletal nutrition. Students will apply advanced theoretical knowledge across nutrition, biomedical sciences, sociology, and counselling, fostering an integrated, multidisciplinary approach to clinical nutrition practice. Through structured case interactions, students will refine their ability to navigate complex clinical decision-making, critically evaluate client needs, and implement evidence-based, socially and culturally appropriate interventions. Reflective practice is embedded to enhance professional growth, self-awareness, and the ability to evaluate and refine clinical approaches.
