

Round #2 – TISSOT UCI Track Nations Cup - Milton May 12-15, 2022

GENERAL INFORMATION

Milton is a town located in Southern Ontario, 40km west of Toronto. On the edge of the Niagara Escarpment, it is one of the fastest growing municipalities in Canada. Since opening the Mattamy National Cycling Centre for the 2015 Pan Am/Parapan Am Games, Milton became the home of Canadian Cycling.

The Mattamy National Cycling Centre is the only velodrome of its kind in Canada, and only the second in North America that meets top international standards. The multi-purpose high performance sports facility serves as both a community recreation facility and a venue for provincial, national and international events such as the Canadian Track Championships, multiple editions of the TISSOT UCI Track Cycling World Cups and the 2020 UCI Para-cycling Track World Championships.

A shuttle service will be provided between the velodrome and official hotels, only for teams booking the CSE accommodation and transport package. The service will be available starting in the morning of the first official day of training, Tuesday May 10.

TRAINING SESSIONS

Official Training at the velodrome

The track will be available for official training on Tuesday May 10 and Wednesday May 11 inclusively. Training schedules will be published on the UCI website once all teams have confirmed their arrival details.

Training Venue – prior to the start of Official Training

The Mattamy National Cycling Centre may be able to accommodate teams arriving early and those who wish to train on the track prior to Tuesday May 10. Please note that availability is limited and will depend on regular private bookings, ongoing Town of Milton programs and event set up.

Important: Please note also that the **track will be closed on Monday, May 9**. There will be no track time available for training and teams will not have access to the infield due to the event set up.

ACCREDITATIONS

Permanence – Accreditation Centre

Accreditations will be available at the Mattamy National Cycling Centre upon arrival for the first time as per official team lists only.

The Permanence will be open according to the following schedule:

All accreditations must be picked up and distributed before further access to the venue is allowed and all payments, including track bookings for unofficial training, will need to be settled before accreditations are released. All team members will need accreditations to access the venue and track centre.

PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

There will be a reserved area for performance analysts on the back straight. Availability is limited (**10 spots**) and bookings will be made on a first come, first serve basis. The cost of this service is **50\$ CAD** (cash). Teams wishing to book a spot must send an email titled PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS to tracknationscup@cyclingcanada.ca. Additional spots could be available, but without access to power.

STORAGE

On-site storage will be accessible from noon (12:00pm) on Monday May 9 to midnight (11:59pm) on Sunday May 15. All teams must empty their storage area by this time. Should you need access to storage prior to Monday May 9, please contact us at tracknationscup@cyclingcanada.ca.

A **100\$ CAD** deposit will have to be made in exchange for the key to access storage which must be paid in cash. The deposit will be returned at the end of the event, only if the key is returned.

PARKING

On-site parking is limited. Teams will receive one (1) team vehicle parking pass. The parking pass will have to be presented to access the parking and must be visible at all times in the parked vehicle. Parking passes will have to be picked up at the Permanence – Accreditation Centre.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS

The doping control room will be well identified in the velodrome, with signage from the track centre and from the accredited entrance. The doping control room will be in an accredited area.
