Elzach / Germany 12th - 15th May 2022



General information about the region

Elzach is situated in southwest Germany in the mountain region of Black Forest at a distance of 30 km from Freiburg, 100 km from Basle (Switzerland), 150 km from Stuttgart, 180 km from Zurich (Switzerland) and 250 km from Frankfurt.

Elzach is about 600 km (6,5 hours car ride) away from Oostende (Belgium) where the 1st of the World Cup takes place from 5th till 8th May 2022.

The Black Forest in the southwest corner of Germany is home to some of the most beautiful scenery in Germany. Its 11,400 square kilometres are home to a rapidly changing landscape, with forests in the north, the less dense central Black Forest, and the mountainous south that leads down to the Rhine.

Black Forest visitors will find rich and varied landscapes, a diverse selection of health and spa resorts, delicious regional food, cultural and architectural treasures, especially in local cities, living regional traditions and a big variety of country sports such as hiking, Nordic walking, mountain biking and cycling, horse riding and golf.

Southwest Germany has a passion for cycle racing. Bike racers can find brilliant conditions for training in the Rhine River Plain and the broad valleys as well as on the panorama and high altitude roads. In between a fair amount of physical challenge with climbs up to 3,000 ft/1,000 m.

Transportation

How to reach the venue :

By plane:

The main International/national airport is Frankfurt, located ~250 km from Elzach.

Alternative airports:

Stuttgart: ~ 150 km

Basle (Switzerland): ~ 100 km

Zurich (Switzerland): ~ 180 km

By train :

Elzach is regularly connected by train with Freiburg im Breisgau. Freiburg itself is connected to the ICE network of Deutsche Bahn and can be reached directly from all major cities in Germany as well as from Frankfurt Airport.

By road :

From Nord (Frankfurt) take the Autobahn A5 exit Offenburg and continue B33 and B294 for about 40 km to Elzach.

From South (Zurich/Basle) take the Autobahn A5 exit Freiburg-Nord and continue B294 for about 30 km to Elzach.

From East (Stuttgart) take the Autobahn A81 exit Rottweil and continue via B462 to Schramberg. Then turn into L108 via Hornberg and L107 to Elzach.

From West (Oostende/France) take the A4 in France to Strasbourg and continue to Offenburg. From Offenburg via B33 and B294 for about 40 km to Elzach.

Race description

Individual Time Trial

The time trials competition start will be held on Schrahöfe, 79215 Elzach. (2 km distance from Elzach). Start is at 381 m above sea level. Finish 1 at 640 m and Finish 2 at 957 m above sea level.

The course is no circuit. Therefore there are two finish lines as follows:

Thursday, 12 th May 2022	12,2 km	Classes: MH1-2; WH1-5, TM1-2, TW1-2
Friday, 13 th May 2022	18,2 km	Classes: MH 3-5, MB, WB, MC1-5, WC1-5

The first 6 km are at a moderate ascent of 2%. After the village of Oberprechtal the ascent increases slightly up to 4 % till finish 1. Between finish 1 and 2 the ascent increases again. The last 3 km will be at a maximum of 9%.

Since the course is one-way, with no return path except the course, riders will be held at the finish area in a large parking area, with team parking, shelters, first aid and refreshments at both finish lines. There will be breaks in the starting order, in which there will be an organized descent to the start area.

An alternative route back to the start is available, but would take nearly 40 minutes. Since it is a one-way route possibility, further details on team support during the time trial will be given at the team managers' meeting by the commissaires.

There will be certain shuttles for equipment from the starting to both finish lines. Schedules will be published.

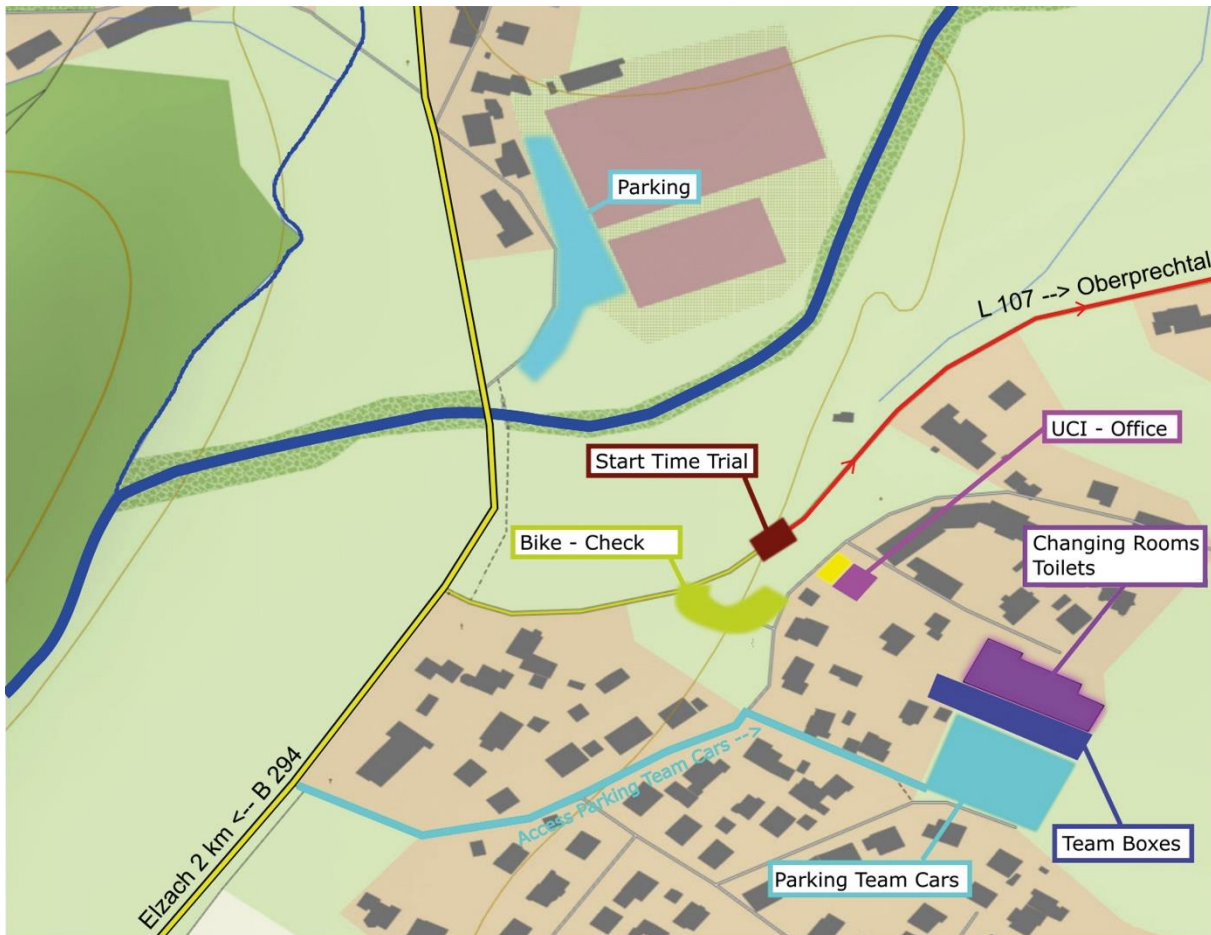
Doping Control will be held at the finish line.

Road Race

Lap: 7,4 km – to be covered several times according to the category in which the cyclist will be compete. Start/Finish-Line will be at Hauptstraße 67, D-79215 Elzach.

The road race will take place in the city centre of Elzach. The circuit is flat and fast. It has a technical and an easier part. The first 500 meters until the exit of the technical part of the circuit will be neutralized starts.

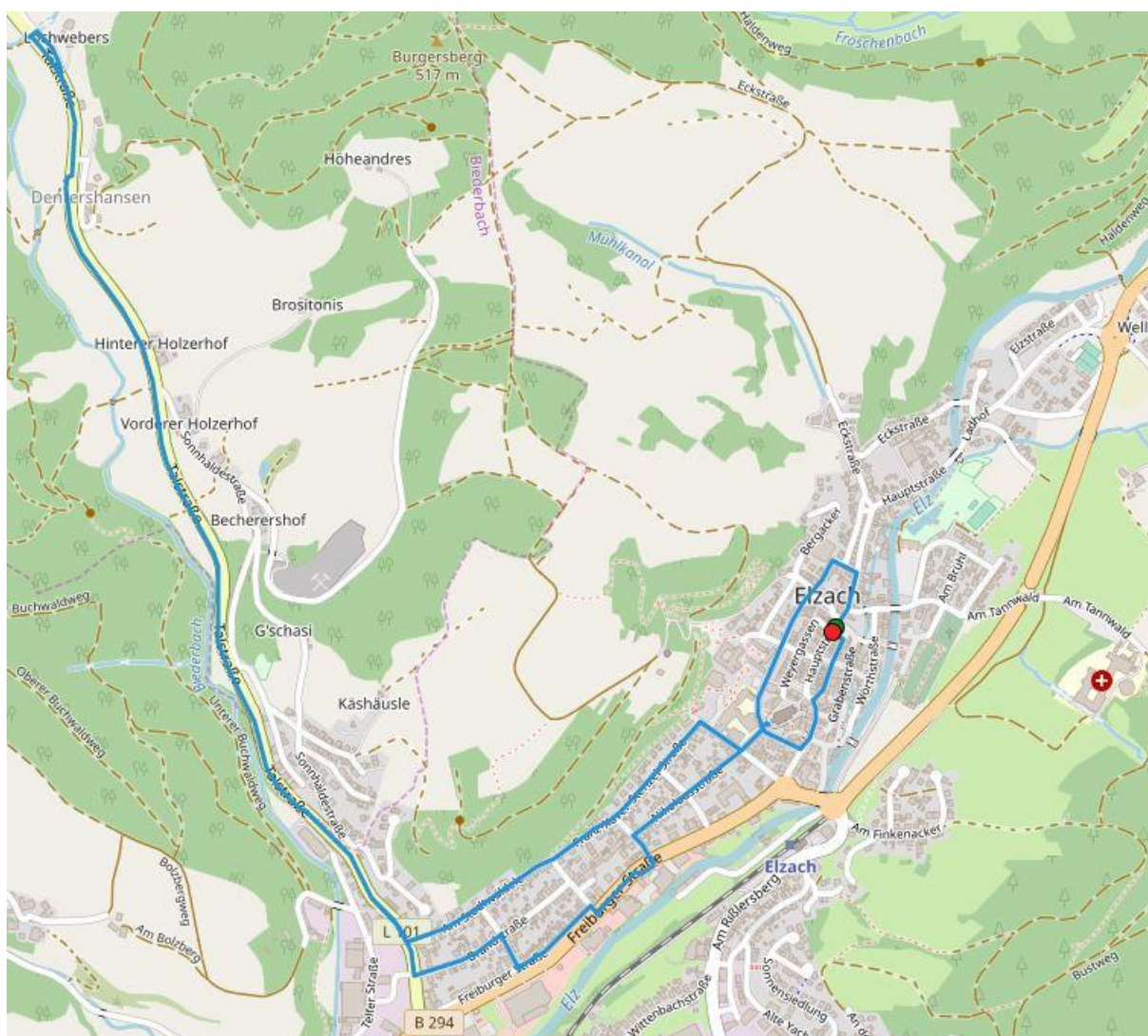

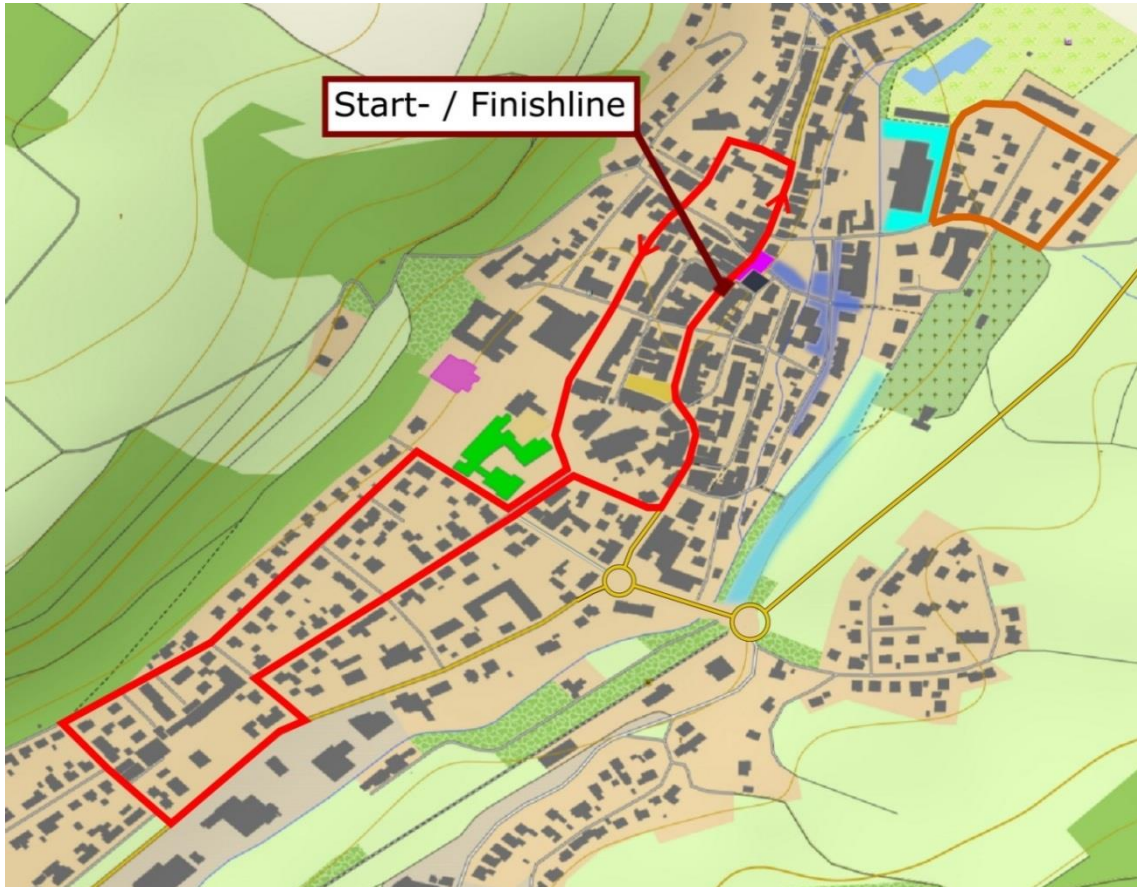

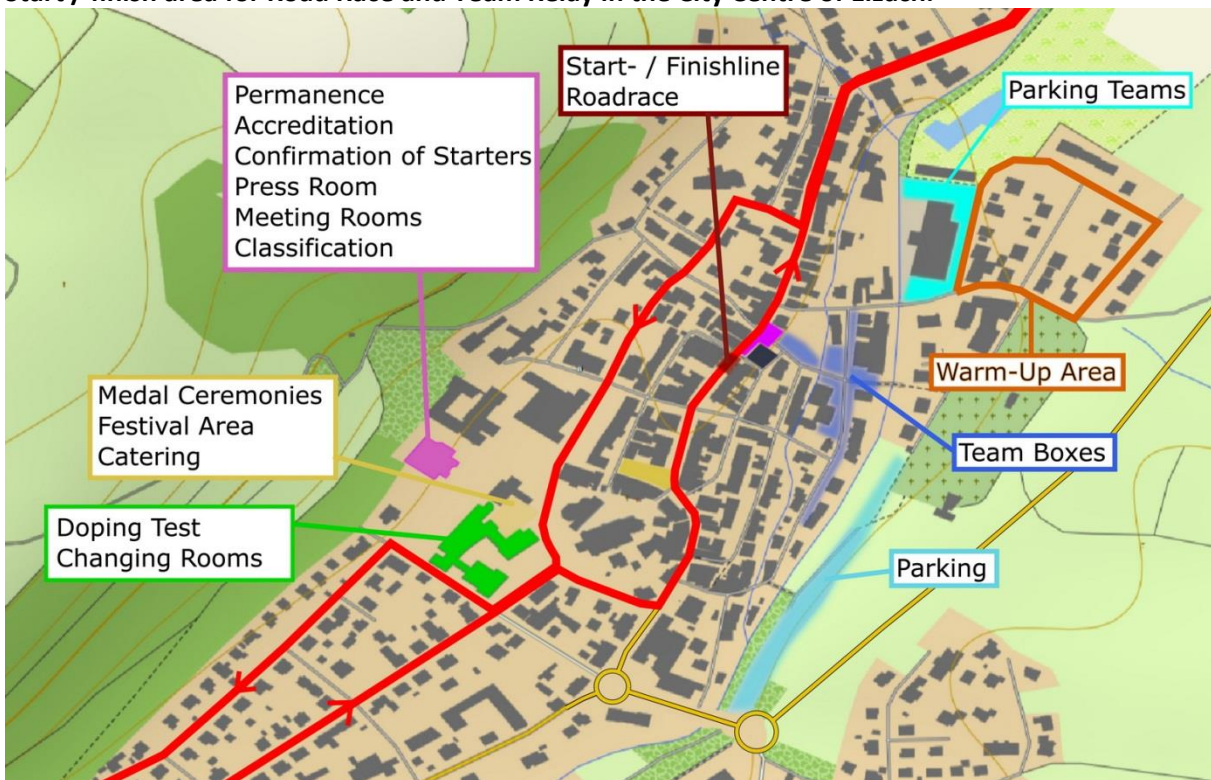


Team Relay, 2,3 km Lap

Registration fee for National Federations

The competition will take place under UCI regulations: <http://www.uci.ch/>

In reference to the UCI regulations (art. 16.20.006) registration shall take place on the UCI online registration website <http://regonline.uci.ch/>

The UCI online registration begins 5 weeks before the event 12:00=(GMT+1) and closes 3 weeks before the event. The maximum number of participants per nation in each event will be six per sport class. The registration dates are available on the UCI website.

The registration fee will be € 75.00 per registration request. Refunds cannot be done for athletes who did not complete the online registration and until payments have been affected, registration cannot be considered as being completed. Only National Federations that have paid their registration fee within the deadline will receive an accreditation and be able to take part in the competition.

Chips/Transponder:

The Organising Committee will provide the Team Manager with a Chip/Transponder for each athlete competing, with a caution fee of € 30.00 each. At the end of the competition the transponder must be returned in exchange for the deposit.

- Damage to property, personal injuries and /or health problems, third-party liabilities

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for the material stored or for any loss.

Official training is free

The roads will be open for public for training. Traffic is not stopped. Hand cyclists must use a caution/safety flag while training.
