COVID PROTOCOL

The Local Organization Committee and the UCI must follow the specific COVID-19 regulations imposed by the French authorities for this event.

These COVID-19 countermeasures are based (but not limited to) on the principle of a "sanitary bubble" which includes specific populations. Sport delegations must be part of this sanitary bubble from arrival to departure to/from the competition.

For these reasons, please make sure to comply with all of the following conditions:

- 1. All sport delegations must use the official transportation and accommodation.
- 2. <u>Before departing for France</u>, all delegations must upload the valid vaccination certificate on the <u>UCI Cloud « Track WC Vaccine certificates »</u>:
 - by 10th October, at the latest
- the PDF versions of **valid vaccination certificate of fully vaccinated members** by naming the files as follows: NAT.First name.Last name.pdf
 - → Valid vaccination means EMA-approved vaccine or similar: 7 days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Vaxzevria/Covishield), 4 weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);
 - For non-European countries, please convert your foreign vaccination certificate into a French Health Pass: https://www.demarches-simplifiees.fr/commencer/passe-sanitaire-etrangers?locale=en
- 3. Bring hard copy of a negative -72 hours RT-PCR Test (at the cost of the national federation). It will be required upon arrival to use the official transportation for the first time, to check in at the official hotel and to get the accreditation card. This applies to all persons (even for vaccinated people and/or people having contracted the Covid-19 within a 6-month period prior to arrival).
 - <u>This test result must be in paper form.</u> It must include a QR code that will be scanned when taking the official transportation for the first time and when checking in and when entering the venue.
- 4. Once in the sanitary bubble, **additional antigenic test(s)** will need to be conducted during the week of the Championships:
- <u>Fully vaccinated members</u> will have to take an antigenic test between Wednesday, 20th October and Thursday, 21st October (at the hotel).
 - → Fully vaccinated means vaccinated with an EMA-approved vaccine or similar: 7 days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Vaxzevria/Covishield), 4 weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);
- <u>Non-vaccinated members (or not vaccinated with an EMA approved vaccine or similar)</u> will have to be tested every day (antigenic test at the hotels).



5. Delegations' members requiring a RT-PCR or antigenic test **to exit France** will be able to take it (at the cost of the national federation) in the event official laboratory (at the venue or at the hotel).

More information on the tests (tests booking, laboratory opening hours...) will be provided on due time. Please note that you will have to wait at the test center for your antigenic test result before being granted entry into the venue.

Besides the measures listed above, everyone must continue to apply the barrier measures (such as <u>wearing a mask at all time</u>, washing hands, using hydro-alcoholic gel, not shaking hands or greeting people with kisses on the cheek...)

VISAS

Each Federation/Team is responsible for complying with the regulations to enter France. More information can be found on the following websites:

Please note that in order to avoid the quarantine requirement upon arrival, the French government and the Local Organization Committee have set up a specific regulation for people entering France from red and orange flagged countries (people coming from / having stayed in these countries within 14 days prior to travelling to France). As mentioned above, according to their vaccine certification or not, buble participants need to follow the COVID-19 test protocol of the organization.

These tests will allow the quarantine requirement to be waived and integrated into the period of presence at the event.

As of 28th September, the categories of countries are as below. This is subject to change based on the sanitary situation.

<u>Countries/territories on the "green" list</u>: countries in the European space (European Union, Andorra, the Holy See, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino and Switzerland), and Albania, Australia, Bahrain, Brunei, Canada, Chile, Comoros Islands, Hong Kong, Japan, Jordan, Kosovo, Lebanon, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Ukraine, Uruguay and Vanuatu.

<u>Countries/territories on the "orange" list</u>: every country/territory in the world, except those on the green list and red list.

<u>Countries/territories on the "red" list</u>: Afghanistan, Algeria, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Georgia, Iran, Maldives, Morocco, Pakistan, Russia, Seychelles, South Africa, Suriname, Tunisia and Turkey
