

UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup – Riders’ registration

We remind that for all categories, registration for the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup are made on the platform [RegOnLine](#) by the National Federation of the rider’s nationality. The opening dates of the platform are [indicated under this link](#).

You will find below a reminder about the participation’s rules to the 2024-2025 UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup - *NF means: National Federation of rider’s nationality.*

Men Elite and Women Elite (ME, WE)

General case: 8 riders per nation, plus 2 substitutes.

The riders in the top 50 of the [latest UCI Cyclo-cross ranking](#) are pre-qualified. For nations with more than 6 riders in the top 50, the following rules apply :

The NF has in the top 50...	The NF must register....	The NF can register....
6 pre-qualified riders	its 6 best ranked riders	2 riders of its choice
7 pre-qualified riders	its 7 best ranked riders	1 rider of its choice
8 pre-qualified riders	its 8 best ranked riders	1 rider of its choice
9 pre-qualified riders	its 8 best ranked riders	2 riders of its choice
10 pre-qualified riders	its 8 best ranked riders	3 riders of its choice
11 pre-qualified riders	its 8 best ranked riders	4 riders of its choice

The NF of the host nation can register 4 additional riders, with a maximum of 12 riders in the case of nations with more than 6 prequalified riders.

Men Elite and Women Elite (ME, WE) when there is no UCI World Cup youth race (MJ, WJ, MU)

The NF can register in the race:

Men Elite: Under 23 or Elite riders. The NF may register 2 additional Under 23 male riders (in the MU section).

Women Elite: Junior, Under 23 or Elite riders. The NF may register 2 additional Junior or Under 23 female riders (in the WU section).

Men Elite and Women Elite (ME, WE) when there are UCI World Cup youth races (MJ, WJ, MU)

The NF can register in the race:

Men Elite: Elite riders. Under 23 riders must compete in the Men Under 23 race.

Women Elite: Under 23 or Elite riders. Junior riders must compete in Women Junior race. The NF may register 2 additional Under 23 female riders (in the WU section).

Men Junior, Women Junior, Men Under 23 (MJ, WJ, MU)

Concerns the following rounds of the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup:

26.11.2024	Dublin (IRL)	29.12.2024	Besançon (FRA)
21.12.2024	Hulst (NED)	19.01.2025	Benidorm Costa Blanca (ESP)
22.12.2024	Zonhoven (BEL)	26.01.2025	Hoogerheide Noord Brabant (NED)

In these 3 categories, each nation may enter 6 riders and 2 substitutes.

For each round except the first one, the leaders of the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup from the MJ, WJ and MU categories can be entered in addition to the 6 riders.

In the Men Under 23 category, the reigning UCI Cyclo-cross World Champion, Tibor DEL GROSSO (NED), can be entered in addition to the 6 riders.

The NF of the host nation can also register 4 additional riders in MJ, WJ and MU.

Obligations of UCI Cyclo-cross Teams

UCI Cyclo-cross Teams: obligation to participate with at least one rider in the Women Elite or Men Elite category at a minimum of five rounds of the UCI World Cup.

UCI Cyclo-cross Professional Teams: obligation to participate with at least three riders of the Women Elite or Men Elite category at each of the UCI World Cup events.
