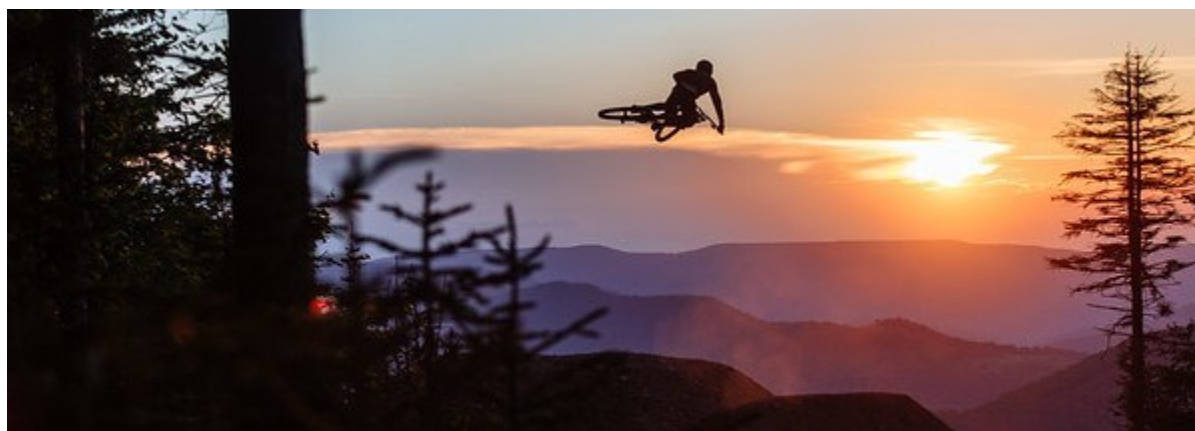

WELCOME TO SNOWSHOE MOUNTAIN



Snowshoe Mountain warmly welcomes all athletes, teams, and spectators for the 2024 UCI Marathon World Championship. Rated as the best resort in the Southeast, Snowshoe Mountain sits at just under 5,000 ft. In the winter we are the biggest and the best with 250+ acres of skiable terrain, including 1500ft vertical on the Western Territory. We average 180 inches of natural snowfall annually, but even when mild winters occur, we are prepared with some of the newest, most innovative technology in snowmaking.

In the heart of summer, we are home to many downhill bike races, one of the most diverse bike parks in the country, cross country trails, hiking, SUP, festivals, beer and wine tastings, concerts and last but not least, cool mountain air. The fall adorns us with foliage as far as the eye can see and even more great festivals.

We have lodging to accommodate 10,000 people, with options ranging from studio condos to 5- bedroom, single-family homes. We are consistently voted the best mountain in the Southeast having significant offerings year-round.

At an elevation of 4,848 feet, Snowshoe Mountain is an 'upside down' resort: our lodging, restaurants, shops and activities are centered in our mountain top Village. This makes for spectacular views and a unique mountain resort experience. Sitting atop the 2nd highest peak in all of West Virginia, the views alone are worth the visit to Forever Wild Snowshoe Mountain.

INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS

The closest international airport is Dulles International Airport near Washington DC, a 4hr drive away.

DOMESTIC AIRPORTS

The Greenbrier Valley Airport in Lewisburg, WV is less than an hour and a half from the top of Snowshoe Mountain. They currently offer daily, nonstop round trips from Chicago and daily one stops from Washington D.C.

For a larger airport that offers more flights, The Pittsburgh International Airport is a great option, less than 4 hours away from the top of the mountain.

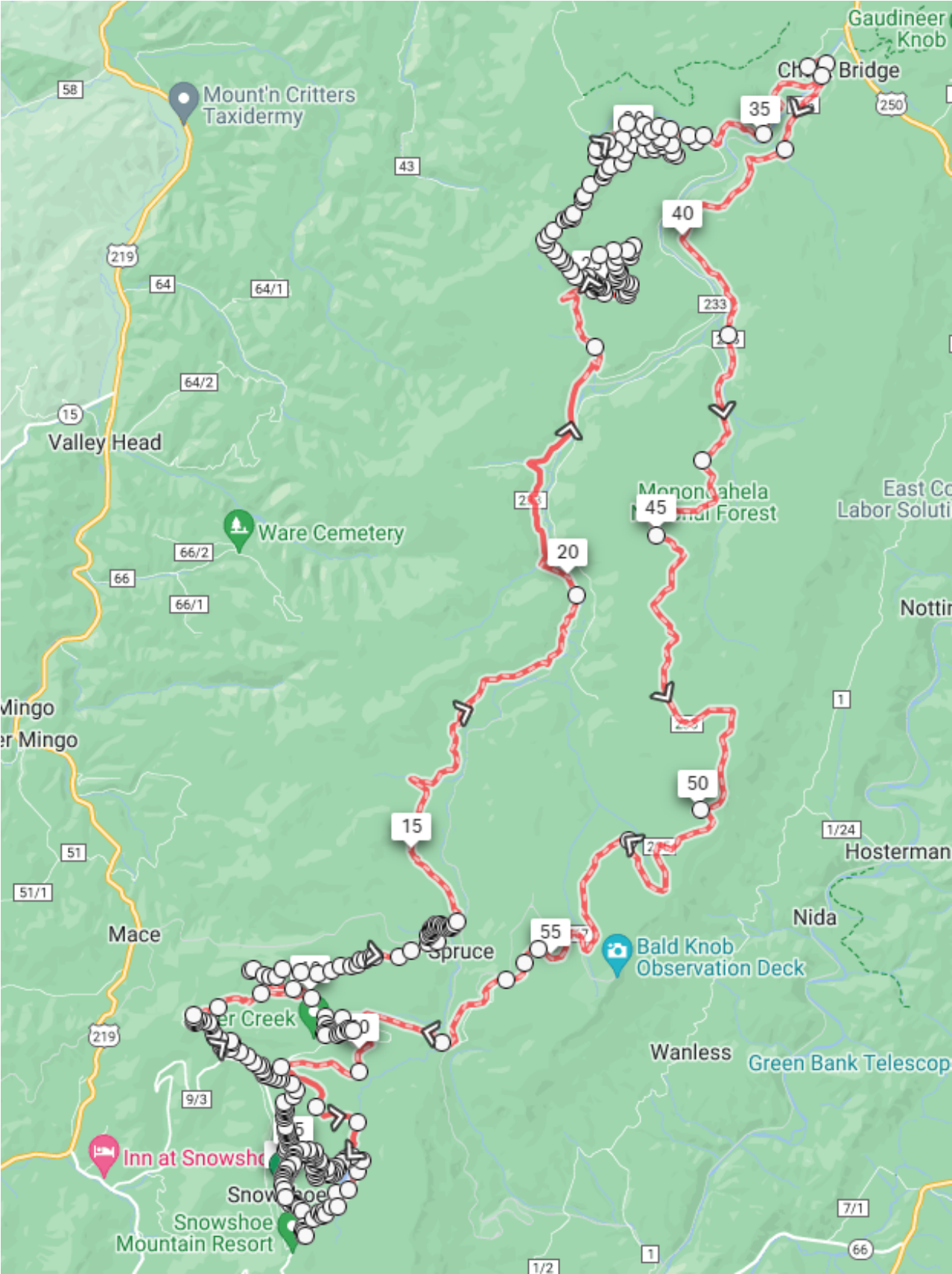

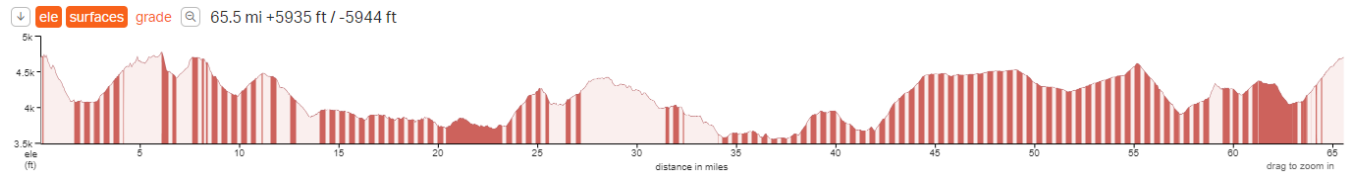

DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping location: Expedition Station, ground floor

The UCI International Events are submitted to anti-doping controls as set forth in the UCI Anti-Doping Rules. The UCI has mandated the International Testing Agency (ITA), an international organization constituted as a not-for-profit foundation which provides independent expert anti-doping services to International Federations, for the purpose of managing the operational activities of UCI's anti-doping program. As such, the ITA is responsible for planning and carrying out the sample collection process during the event.
