ROUBAIX (FRA) 20 – 24.10.2021



Introduction

This document summarises the information needed by the National Federations for their riders' participation in the 2021 UCI Track Cycling World Championships presented by TISSOT:

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Mainly intended for team managers, this document focuses on the purely sporting aspects of the World Championships. For more information on other matters (accommodation, meetings, accreditation...) see the end of this document for useful addresses.

1. COVID PROTOCOL

The Local Organization Committee and the UCI must follow the specific COVID-19 regulations imposed by the French authorities for this event.

These COVID-19 countermeasures are based (but not limited to) on the principle of a **"sanitary bubble"** which includes specific populations. Sport delegations must be part of this sanitary bubble from arrival to departure to/from the competition.

For these reasons, please make sure to comply with all the following conditions:

- 1. All sport delegations must use the official transportation and accommodation.
- 2. Fully vaccinated participants* **must upload their official vaccination certification** on the convert format on the dedicated platform.

*Please notice that "fully vaccinated" means vaccinated with an EMA-approved vaccine or similar: 7 days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Vaxzevria/Covishield), 4 weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);

The vaccination certification must be uploaded as PDF file and must be named as follows (according to the population category) :

TEAMS.XXX.first name.last name.pdf (XXX refers to the UCI tricode of the nation)

For administrative management reasons, these instructions must be absolutely followed. Any file which does not respect this format and is not named accordingly cannot be considered and will be rejected. Please upload you vaccination certificate before <u>15th October</u>.

If the participant doesn't upload his vaccination certification on the platform before he/she collects his/her accreditation, he/she will be considered as a **non-vaccinated person and will have to be tested every day.**

3. One negative -72 hours PCR Test (at the cost of the national federation) is required upon arrival to collect the accreditation card. This applies to all persons (even for vaccinated people and/or people having contracted the Covid-19 within a 6-month period prior to arrival).

This test result must be in paper form (hard copy) with the accreditation ID written on it.



- 4. In the sanitary bubble, **additional antigenic test(s)** will need to be conducted during the week of the Championships:
 - <u>Fully vaccinated members</u> will have to do **an antigenic test** between Wednesday, 20th October and Thursday, 21st October (at the hotel).

 \rightarrow Please notice that "fully vaccinated" means vaccinated with an EMA-approved vaccine or similar: 7 days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Vaxzevria/Covishield), 4 weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);

• <u>Non-vaccinated members</u> (or not vaccinated with an EMA approved vaccine or similar) will have **to be tested every day** (antigenic test at the hotels). In order to facilitate your access to the velodrome, a daily sticker will be add to your accreditation after your test.

Please notice that you will have to wait at the test center for your antigenic test result before being granted entry into the venue.

A COVID test center will be set up on every teams hotel.

Opening hours : Wednesday 20 and Thursday 21 : from 8am to noon / The other days : from 08:00 to 10:00

5. To exit France members requiring a PCR or antigenic test will be able to do it (Cost supported by the national federation) at the event official laboratory (at the venue or at the hotel).

Non-compliance of participants to this protocol will result by denied access the competition site and withdrawal of accreditation.

Besides the measures listed above, everyone must continue to apply the barrier measures (such as wearing a mask at any times, washing hands, using hydro-alcoholic gel, not shaking hands, or greeting people with kisses on the cheek...)

2. ACCREDITATIONS

Please note that each National Federation taking part in the UCI Track Cycling World Championships must register with the UCI all persons included in the delegation, using the online registration system <u>uci.getyourevent.online</u> in order to get an accreditation for:

- Riders
- And all other persons included in the delegation (team manager, staff, coaches, officials, guests, etc)

The venue will be fully accredited from **Monday 18th October**.

Please ensure that you collect your accreditation as soon as you arrive at the velodrome as it will be required for access to all parts of the venue (make sure to check the process to collect all accreditations of the team on the next page). Accreditations are provided with a lanyard and must be worn and visible whenever you pass through accreditation controls.

You are responsible for the safe keeping of your accreditation. If your pass is lost or stolen, please inform the Accreditation Centre immediately. Any abuse of the system such as passing your accreditation to another person will be reported to the UCI and your accreditation may be withdrawn.

Team Accreditations can be collected from the Accreditation Centre located on the **ground floor** of the Velodrome during opening hours.

UCI ACCREDITATION CENTRE OPENING TIMES

To avoid misunderstandings, the Union Cycliste Internationale has decided to fix a limit for the maximum number of accreditations which can be issued (as stipulated in the Registration Procedure). The number of accreditation cards is valid for a complete team; consequently, it will be adapted to the number of riders who will take part in the Championships.



3. NATIONAL TEAMS ACCREDITATIONS DELIVERY

- Pick-up of several/all team members' accreditations is allowed under these conditions:
 - To be done by Team Managers and Coaches only
 - Only if badge holders are already in Roubaix (badges for members that arrive later must be collected on the day of <u>their</u> arrival!)

PREPARE BEFORE ARRIVAL:

- Every Team Manager and Coach will receive a link to a web page of the GetYourEvent platform, where she/he will be able to check their accreditation requests that are still missing a photograph and, in case of need, upload the photo files (in .jpg or .bmp format). The same link will be sent to the official email address of her/his National Federation.
- From the same page she/he will be able to recover the **ID number of the accreditation**.
- She/He will have to write that ID number on the top right corner of a printed copy of the <u>PCR-test/vaccination document*</u>: the correct association of the staff member to the id number and the validity of the tests (truthfulness, date etc.) are completely under her/his responsibility.

- The email will be sent from <u>uci@getyourevent.online</u>. Please make sure that this email address is not spammed from your email client.
- If you do not receive the link before Saturday 15th October, please write an email to info@wingsmedia.it to receive it.

ONSITE AT THE ACCREDITATION CENTRE:

- 1. Go to the Accreditation center and pick-up your accreditation(s):
 - Please note that the National Federations badges will not be valid to access the velodrome until they will be completed with a sticker from the Covid-19 Documentation Office, located besides the Accreditation Centre.

2. Go to the COVID-19 DOCUMENTATION OFFICE (besides the accreditation centre)

- Present <u>a hard copy of a negative -72-hour PCR Test, for each of the badge holder sorted out</u> <u>by accreditation ID number.</u> Tests must be carried out not earlier than 3 days before the accreditation pick-up.
- There, you will receive a specific sticker that will allow you to enter the velodrome. Without that sticker, the access to the venue is impossible.

NOTE: IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO PRINT ANY DOCUMENT AT THE COVID-19 DOCUMENTATION OFFICE!

Please make sure to arrive on site with the necessary documents. IT IS NECESSARY TO AVOID TEAM MANAGERS/COACH FROM QUEUEING ALL DAY AT THE COVID-19 DOCUMENTATION OFFICE.



ACCREDITATION ZONES

Accreditation access zones are defined as follows:

If you feel that you do not have clearance for a zone which is necessary for your work, please contact the Accreditation Centre.

Due to the COVID Protocol, accredited persons (except for video analysts) will not be able to access the spectator hall.

Please be mindful that many of the event personnel you will encounter at the velodrome are volunteers so please treat them with courtesy as without them the event would not be able to happen.

4. DETAILED VENUE SCHEDULE

5. TRAINING SESSIONS

OFFICIAL TRAINING: Monday, 18 October and Tuesday, 19 October

The track will be open for Official Training Sessions on Monday, 18 and Tuesday, 19 October, from 09:00 to 19:30 with a 1h45 slot per group.

The detailed time schedules of the official training sessions will be established at the closing of the online registration system and published on the <u>UCI website</u>. Teams must respect the slots as defined in the schedule.

Official training session on competition days: These sessions are open to riders not competing on that day. On Wednesday, the session is split into training for sprinters and training for endurance riders in order to allow everybody to make specific efforts without endangering others.

Warm-up sessions: The track is open before competitions for riders competing in the next session only. The track closes 10 minutes before the start of the competitions' session.

Reminder: The use of starting gates or derny is prohibited during all training and warm-up sessions. Standing starts are permitted only with the agreement of the UCI Technical Delegate. The standing start shall take place on the home straight only, in the sprinters' lane and only with the assistance of someone waving a flag at the exit of the bend.

Only one coach per team is allowed on the safety zone, on the home straight, during training and warm-up sessions. Coaches must coordinate with each other for a better secure and efficient use of the track.

All riders must wear the national team apparel.

During training and warm-up sessions, UCI Rules must be respected. The UCI Technical Delegate has the power to take the necessary measures to ensure security on one hand and equity among the other teams on the other.

Rider numbers will be distributed at the team managers meeting. <u>We request a maximum</u> representation of two people per team attending the meeting.

Attendance is required by:

UCI Technical Delegate, UCI Commissaires, UCI Doping Control Officer, Event Director, Event Manager, Competition Manager, Race Doctor, Team Managers.

Attendance at the Team Manager's meeting is compulsory. In the case of non-attendance, Team Managers shall be sanctioned with a fine of CHF 300.- (as per art. 9.1.023)

7. COMMUNIQUES

Considering the environment, all communiqués, results and start lists will be displayed on a whiteboard in the infield. Hard copies will also be distributed however the amount of copies will be adapted as per the number of participants; 1 copy per participant. General Communiqués 1 to 6 will be printed upon request only. They will however be available on <u>www.tissottiming.com</u>



8. TEAM MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE AREAS

Storage areas will be allocated to the teams according to the numbers of riders entered. On-site storage will be accessible from Sunday, 17 October 3 pm to 6 pm until Monday, 25 October 10 am. Should you need access to storage outside these dates, please contact us: Laetitita MONZO, <u>l.monzo@ffc.fr</u>

The Team Cabin Coordinator will meet each team on arrival and show you to your allocated cabin. It is important that teams only use the cabin allocated to them. Due to the numbers of teams entered and space limitations it will be necessary for some smaller teams to share cabins.

A security deposit of € 100,00 in cash must be paid for key when picking it up at the key issuing room, that is located **in the infield at the Team Desk**. Please ensure you sign your key back in at the end of the event, no later than 10.00 am on Monday, 25th October. The deposit will be returned once the team cabin has been inspected and is left in the condition in which it was issued to you. Your deposit will not be returned if there is any damage to the team cabin and you may incur additional repair costs if the damage exceeds the initial deposit.

Lost keys – if your team misplaced the key for your team cabin, a replacement key is available from the team cabin coordinator. Teams will be responsible for the cost of replacing lost keys. Key replacement cost is \leq 50,00 per key.

9. TRACK CENTRE TEAM PENS

Track centre boxes will be available from **Monday, 18th October at 8:00 am.**

Team boxes are allocated in the track centre considering the size of each team. Due to the large number of people on the track centre, the space is limited, and we ask you to keep to your allocated area.

Teams are reminded that only equipment to be used on the day can be located infield, others must be stored in team cabins.

Fire Regulations insist that corridors in the track center are maintained for emergency evacuation purposes. To ensure the track center can be cleared quickly and safely in an emergency please ensure equipment does not excessively narrow or block walkways.

Team Pens will have one table and chairs. **We ask the teams for cooperation and fair play; do not take furniture that is in other boxes**. Please ask the organizer if you need additional equipment.

Teams' pits will be powered with 230V, standard 2-pin outlet. The venue requires that all electrical equipment meets EU Standards to meet safety requirements. Teams must have all appliances tested and tagged by a qualified electrician. Please **do not plug extension leads into this socket or kettles, coffee machines or fan heaters** as they use high power consumption and may cause the supply to fail.

WIFI will be available for teams in the velodrome.



10. TEAM PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

Teams wishing to have a spot for their performance/video analysts have to reserve it by sending an email to contact Laetitita MONZO, <u>l.monzo@ffc.fr</u> until 14th October.

Performance/Video Analysts area is located at the spectator hall (opposite) on a platform. Please note that there is a limited number of spots and they will be distributed on a first come, first served basis. The cost for a position is \leq 100,00.

Please note that NF will not be able to set up their own wireless networks as they interfere with other equipment in use. All "unofficial" set up will be immediately deinstalled.

11. TEAM VIDEOGRAPHER

- The green bibs can be collected at the Accreditation Center.
- A deposit of € 50.00 is requested per bib.
- Team video people are allowed to film nor publish footage with images of the staging before the races, the races and the awards ceremonies even if they are located in the areas dedicated to the athletes and teams.



- Team video people are only allowed to film "behind the scenes" and interviews with the riders in the team areas, but not at officially dedicated areas for media of the 2021 Tissot UCI Track Cycling World Championships.
- Team video people do not have access to the press center of the 2021 Tissot UCI Track Cycling World Championships.
- Team video people will have to accept and always give priority to the needs of the Host Broadcaster and will not interfere with its work.
- Team video people must respect under all circumstances the instructions of the staff members of the UCI.
- Team video people respectively the federation which the Teamvideo operators represent will not broadcast any interview with an athlete filmed or recorded within the event venue any earlier than 90 minutes after the end of the last race of each competition day on the team's website or social media channels.

12. COMPETITION CLOTHING

The wearing of national team clothing is mandatory at World Championships. Team Managers must therefore present the national team clothing to the College of Commissaires at the confirmation of starters for validation.

Besides, riders of the same national team must wear identical racing shorts during the same event, except for advertising space included in a lateral band 9 cm wide, which may differ from one rider to another. This means that National Federations must also provide their riders with national racing shorts.



13. DURING COMPETITIONS

Onboard cameras

Onboard cameras will be used and provided by the UCI for the TV production. The UCI thanks the teams for their cooperation in advance.

Track flow/Mixed zone area:

During final sessions, all riders, included winners will have to exit the track on the back straight and go through the media mixed zone. In media mixed zone, all riders shall pass by foot. No bikes will be allowed in that zone. During interviews, rider **must be standing**.

14. TEAM CHANGING ROOMS

There are male and female changing rooms and shower facilities available at the STAB Velodrom on the ground floor. Please follow the directional signage.

15. ADDITIONAL TEAMS SERVICES

Water Supply

The LOC will provide all teams with water during training and competition days.

The issuing point will be in one of the changing room available:

- Wednesday 20th to Friday 22nd: From 9 am to 11am From 4.30 pm to 6.30 pm
- Saturday 23rd: From 8 am to 10 am From 3.30 pm to 5.30 pm
- Sunday 24th: From 8am to 9.30 From 12.30 pm to 2.00 pm

Rollers: The LOC will not provide rollers.

Ice bath: The LOC will not provide rooms or services related to an ice bath.

Riding in the venue: Riding bicycles in the corridors is prohibited at all times.

17. AWARD CEREMONIES

The World Champion, the second and the third placed riders shall be ready for the official ceremony that shall be conducted under the responsibility of the Chief Commissaires. For team events, the additional reserve rider will be allowed on the podium (art. 9.1.045).

Riders shall appear in racing attire, wearing their national jerseys but bare-headed and without headband or glasses, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure.

As per art. 9.1.050, a World Champion may not wear the jersey identifying his title and bearing the regulation advertisement of his main sponsor(s) until, at earliest, the day following that on which he received it. Any infringement of the provisions of articles 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 above shall be punished by a fine of CHF 2'000 to CHF 10'000. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the offence.



Besides, it is reminded that the right to the rainbow colours remains the exclusive property of the UCI, including the **design of the World Champion's jersey**. Strict rules must be observed in the manufacture of your World Champion's jersey (UCI Jersey Guidelines). It is thus compulsory to have the jersey and other equipment using the rainbow colours approved by the UCI prior to manufacture, otherwise severe penalties may be imposed (art. 1.3.072). Accordingly, the designs (jersey, equipment, etc.) must be sent to the UCI Track Department for approval via the following e-mail address: track@uci.ch

19. DOPING CONTROL

Doping Control tests will be carried out by the 2015 Anti-doping Rules of the UCI and ITA procedures and instructions.

Riders selected for anti-doping will be identified on a list by their race number or their ranking. If applicable, the list will be posted on the infield and at the entrance of the doping control station immediately after the race.

The riders selected for the controls will be notified by a chaperon; the notified rider shall remain within sight of the chaperon at all times from the moment of in-person notification until the completion of the sample collection procedure.

Even if there are chaperons present, ultimately IT IS THE RIDERS' RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK IF THEY HAVE BEEN SELECTED FOR ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS.

20. MEDICAL TEAM

A team of doctors and paramedics, based in the track centre, will be present throughout official training and competition.

The medical team will be available from the start of the training session to the end of the competitions.

Outside official training and competition times, emergency medical care is available by dialling **112** (emergency only).



24. RIDERS TRAINING ON THE ROADS

Riders will be authorized to train on the roads and commute by bike between their hotel and the velodrome. However, as per the COVID-19 protocol it is strictly forbidden to stop in any public space. Any breach to the COVID-19 Protocol may lead to the withdrawal of the accreditation and quarantine.

Whilst out on the roads remember to not drive on the highway. After dark you will require a front and back light fitted to your bike. Red traffic signal lights mean "stop". Ensure you adhere to all road signs and do not ride on the footway; this is illegal and may result in a fine. Please make sure you have your ID with you when you are outside the venue.
