Tel Aviv is the sporting capital of Israel. On top of many annual events, such as the Tel Aviv Marathon, Triathlon, Night Run, Cycling Marathon, with each attracting thousands from Israel and abroad, many elite sporting events discovered the city’s potential; FIBA, IJF and other international federations held a major event in the city – and came back for more. The city also hosted the finish of stage 2 of the 2018 Giro D’Italia, the first time a Grand Tour began outside of Europe.

TRAINING SESSIONS**Official training sessions**

Official training sessions will be held August 19-22, 2022. The training schedule will be published on the UCI website once registration has closed.

Training prior to the Official training sessions

The track will be closed on August 18th, 2022 for final preparations but track time before this day can be booked. Teams who are interested in arriving earlier are kindly asked to contact the LOC at info@comtecint.com by June 20th, 2022. According to the demand, the level of services available and costs will be determined and communicated.

STORAGE

The storage area will be available and secured as of August 18th, 2022 in the morning. The storage will be done in 2.5m’ X 5 m’ covered cages, in proximity to the velodrome building. More information (including keys pick-up, sharing, etc.) will be provided at a later stage.

PARKING

Free parking at the venue will be reserved for teams. Parking in other parts of Tel Aviv, like most big cities in the world, is not an easy task. Some hotels hold limited parking, many in the city center do not. Please note while parking in the city that blue and white painted sidewalks means paid parking area (usually done through an App - [Pango](#) is the most popular and has an English interface). Red and white painted sidewalks means parking is prohibited.

PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS' AREA

A platform behind the backstraight will be reserved for the team's analysts. Space is limited and allows 8 cameramen to work simultaneously. A table will be shared to secure on each day - preliminaries and finals. The spots will be allocated on a "first comes first served" basis and will need to be secured each day for qualifications and finals. 220V Electricity will be available.

Holders of passports from countries who are not included in the list should approach the Israeli embassy in their country for visa. If you require a visa and do not have an Israeli embassy in your country, please also contact Yamit.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

Here are the procedures in place at the moment:

1. Before Arrival
 - a. 48 hours prior to landing in Israel, each arriving person is required to fill an individual online declaration, and state that he or she does not suffer from any symptoms or has been recently exposed to a sick person
 - b. PCR or antigen tests prior to boarding flights to Israel or upon arrival are all canceled, starting May 21st.
2. Upon arrival
 - a. No specific restrictions are in force at the moment.
3. During the event
 - a. No special limitations are in order, but just as precaution manners:
 - i. Social distancing should be kept as much as possible
 - ii. Sanitation facilities will be available at the hotels and the venue and should be used as much as possible

All LOC members, hotel workers, bus drivers, pool workers and others who may come in contact with the competition participants will be fully vaccinated.

- **“SHABBAT”:**

According to the Jewish calendar, the date changes at sunset. The 7th day (starting at sunset on Friday, called “Shabbat” in Hebrew) is the Holy day, and as a result some places will be closed. In others (such as hotels), there will be some minor changes in the breakfast or lunch menu, and some other changes such as the use of the “Shabbat” Elevator, which will stop on each floor on that day. Public transportation (buses and trains) will also stop working from about 2-3 hours before Shabbat, till about an hour after. Shuttle service to and from the venue will of course work as usual.
