GENERAL INFORMATION

CLIMATE: March, the first month of the spring in Cairo, is a warm month, with temperature in the range of an average low of 11.6°C (52.9°F) and an average high of 23.5°C (74.3°F). In Cairo, the average relative humidity in March is 53%. In Cairo, the average sunshine in March is 8.7h.

VISAS

Visitors must hold passports that are valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival to Egypt.

Visitors to Egypt must obtain a visa from one of the Egyptian Diplomatic Missions unless they come from one of the visa exempt countries or countries that are eligible for attainment of a visa on arrival. To confirm which respective country's visa requirements are for entry into Egypt, contact should be made with the local Egyptian Consulate in each country or by checking on www.mfa.gov.eg

Eligible travellers can get a visa on arrival at one of the bank counters before going through security at a cost of approximately \$25.00.

There are a number of countries whose residents are eligible for an e-visa before arrival which can be done at <https://visa2egypt.gov.eg/eVisa>.

Those nations that need to arrange visas through the local consulate will need an official invitation letter and this can be arranged by contacting nations@caironationscup2023.com – details required on an official federation letterhead are as follows:

- Full name of each traveller (as it appears in the passport)
- Passport number
- Travel dates – arrival & departure

INSURANCE

All participants (included but not limited to team officials, riders and their assistants) must bear their own responsibility for any injury, accident and/or loss that may occur during their stay in Egypt while taking part in the championships or any associated activity. Participants should organise insurance before leaving their country in order to protect themselves against any loss and to indemnify themselves against any claims, including any treatments that may be required at hospitals etc.
