## STAFF AND DELEGATION ACCREDITATIONS FOR NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

This document outlines the accreditation quotas for National Federation staff and delegation, not including riders and sport directors. Please review the instructions and procedures below.

A maximum number of staff and delegation accreditation is allocated for each National Federation. It is up to each National Federation to adapt its staff and delegation accreditation requests depending on its needs for each of the races.

The total number of staff and delegation accreditations is based on the total number of riders that took part in the Road events in the previous 2024 UCI Road & Para-Cycling Road World Championships in Zurich.

If the number of riders (based on the qualification system) taking part in the 2025 UCI Road World Championships increases from the previous year, the National Federation may request for additional accreditations.

Within the above-mentioned maximum number of accreditations, each National Federation may accredit the following individuals according to their function within the delegation:

The riders and sport directors registered in the 2025 UCI Road World Championships receive an accreditation automatically. They are not included in the quota of the staff and delegation and there is no need to apply for them.
